

Hillah Shriners Leave on Pilgrimage to Sacramento This Evening

30 CANDIDATES TO TREAD HOT SANDS AT BIG CONCLAVE

Neptune Party Will Be Feature of Entertainment in California Capital—Four States Will Participate

A special train, bearing Shriners of Hillah Temple and 30 candidates for degrees of the Mystic Shrine will leave the Rogue River valley this evening for Sacramento, Cal., where the Shrine will hold a gigantic ceremonial under auspices of Ben Ali Temple.

Headed by Potentate William P. Neville, the officials of Ben Ali Temple of Sacramento are preparing to entertain 2500 nobles. Neville informed nobles that the ceremonial will be the most elaborate affair ever to be attempted by the temple.

Added to Shriners within the jurisdiction of Ben Ali Temple, including all the Superior California counties, others will attend from the San Francisco Bay area and Los Angeles.

In addition to the large class of candidates which will be sent from southern Oregon, at least fifty other candidates will be initiated, including several high ranking naval officers from Vallejo.

Other out-of-state Shriners are expected from Utah and Nevada.

Potentate C. A. Carson, Jr., will head the divan from Kerak Temple of Reno, Nev., and the complete divan of El Kalah Temple of Salt Lake City, headed by Potentate George R. Corry, also is expected. A portion of the divan of Al Malakah Temple of Los Angeles will be present, along with dignitaries from the bay region.

The Southern Oregon Hillah special will arrive at Sacramento at 10:30 a. m. Saturday. An early morning stop will be made at Chico, where Butte county members of Ben Ali Temple will board the train, which will then proceed to Marysville, where the Shriners will stop for breakfast and a concert and parade and will pick up Yuba and Sutter county members of Ben Ali.

Potentate Neville will send an official delegation to Marysville to meet the Oregonians and to proceed to Sacramento with them.

At Sacramento the Shriners will be met by the Sacramento Shriners at the Southern Pacific station, and a parade will be started from there to the Hotel Senator, where Illustrious Potentate O. O. Alenderfer of Hillah Temple will have his headquarters.

The various units of Ben Ali Temple will entertain like units of visiting Shriners throughout the day.

At 4 p. m. a colorful parade will be held, in which will march the various uniformed bodies of Ben Ali and Hillah Temples, including bands, drum corps and drill teams, and the local visiting nobles.

The Ben Ali Temple divan members, attired in their elaborate and colorful robes, as well as the visiting dignitaries, will participate in the parade.

The parade will form on J street, east of Fifteenth, and will proceed down to Second, over Second to K, and out K to Fifteenth, from where the line of march will lead to the Sacramento Memorial auditorium.

In the auditorium a banquet will be served, to which all nobles, both local and visiting, will be invited. Places will be held for from 1,200 to 2,500 guests.

Following the banquet will be a brief business session, and the ceremonial will commence promptly at 7:30 p. m.

The following day, Sunday, a golf tournament will be held on the Del Paso Country club course, starting at 10 a. m. The visitors will be entertained throughout the day and the Oregon delegation will leave Sacramento at 8 p. m.

Will Come From Wide Area Shriners from the following Superior California cities and their vicinities will attend the ceremonial: Stockton, Lodi, Vallejo, Rio Vista, Siletto, Courtland, Carlsburg, Polson, Fincerville, Roseville, Auburn, Grass Valley, Nevada City, Colfax, Lincoln, Marysville, Yuba City, Colusa, Gridley, Oroville, Chico, Red Bluff, Redding, Dunsmuir, Mount Shasta, Yreka, Woodland, Arbutic, Williams, Woodland and Corning.
