

MANY EGGS FROM DESCHUTES TROUT

BEND, Nov. 22—(AP)—Eighteen million trout eggs were taken by the Oregon game commission in the Deschutes country this year for distribution to lakes and streams of the state and the enjoyment of sportsmen.

East lake, nesting in Newberry crater, yielded about 13,000,000 of these eggs. The rest were taken at Elk lake, where unusual, and as yet unexplained conditions, prevented a larger yield. It was found that at Elk lake spawning trout, for some unknown reason, did not approach the shores during the daylight. The egg-taking crews, therefore, had to work at night, and in darkness, because searchlights frightened the fish from the banks. Most of the eggs were taken to the

Klamath hatchery for the first stages of fish growth. Buttons Boosted Angling Fees SACRAMENTO, Cal. (UP)—Buttons were believed to have played an important part in increasing by \$40,000 the number of fishing licenses issued in California this year. Anglers were furnished with large buttons; which they were required to wear conspicuously. It was difficult for fishermen to escape payment of the license fees, which will total approximately \$400,000.

PORTLAND SCHOOL COST RATES LOW

PORTLAND, Nov. 22—(AP)—The cost of educating a pupil in Portland high and elementary schools is \$72.94 annually, placing Portland third lowest in a list of 24 American

cities having a population over 300,000. Charles A. Rice, superintendent of schools here, was advised of the rating today by the federal office of education. Only Louisville and New Orleans have a lower average cost than Portland. New York heads the list with a cost per pupil of \$138.53. Seattle was 20th with a cost of \$84.74 each.
