TVA TOWN CRIMELESS; OFFICERS SPEND TIME ANSWERING QUESTIONS

NORRIS, Tenn. (UP)—A description of Norris, the Tennessee Valley Authority's model town sounds like a policeman's dream it never has had a murder or other major crime.

It hasn't even a jail. Yet it has an extremely capable police force of 21 men, who give 24-hour protection to the town and dam site.

Most of the Norris policemen are college graduates. All are tall, athletic looking, and crack shots.

The police force is commanded by K. A. Bouse, graduate of the University of Chicago, where he was an all-American football player and captain of the squad in 1927. His assistant is H. E. Fischer, graduate of Virginia Military Institute, also a former football star.

The Norris police spend most of their time answering questions, for they serve as guides for the visitors to the town and dam site. All members of the force are first aid experts and frequently have treated persons injured in automobile accidents in and near Norris.

The Norris officers wear distinctive uniforms consisting of black riding boots, forest green breeches, tan poplin shirts with black ties, gray campaign hats and Sam Brown belts with pistol holsters.
