HOLIDAY DESSERTS

All of a sudden the holidays are here! Thanksgiving, Christmas, New Year! Is there a person who can't find a bit of enthusiasm for the old customs surrounding this season? The hospitality of our warm friends, be they even quite plain, is just naturally especially sincere and generous when we seem to hear the jingle of Christmas bells coming close.

Among favorite holiday refreshments certainly those prepared and served from our electric refrigerators are the most delicious—and the variations are unending. Listing a few:

Water Ice—A combination of sugar, water and fruit juices.

Frappé—A water ice frozen only slightly—may be served nicely as a cocktail or with meat as well as a dessert.

Sherbet—Made by using milk or cream, egg whites or gelatin to the water ice combination.

Ice Cream—A combination of thin cream, sugar and flavoring, thickened by eggs, corn starch, tapioca or some such agent.

Mousse—Whipped cream, sweetened and flavored.

Parfait—Combination of beaten eggs, heavy syrup and whipped cream flavored and usually decorated elaborately.

Sundae—Ice cream served with crushed fruit or some other sweet sauce.

Frozen Puddings—Just what the name indicates.

Ice Box Cakes—Usually a shell of cake, cookies or crackers with a filling of rich custard or whipped cream.

Fruit Whip—A fruit mixture held up by beaten egg whites and sugar.

Sponge—Usually a gelatin whipped or combined with beaten cream or egg whites.

Mallow—The foundation is marshmallows used as a thickening agent.

20 marshmallows.

1 cup milk.

1 cup whipping cream.

1/4 cup maraschino cherries.

3 slices pineapple.

1/2 cup nut meats.

1 teaspoon vanilla.

Heat the milk in the top of a double boiler (or on low heat). Add marshmallows. Dissolve over hot water, stirring frequently. Cool. Whip cream until thick (not stiff) and fold into the cooled mixture. Add chopped fruit and nuts then flavoring. Freeze without stirring.

Fruit Sponge: 1 tablespoon gelatin, 4 egg whites, 1/2 cup sugar, 1 banana, 1/4 teaspoon salt.

1 orange, peeled and sliced, 1/2 cup crushed pineapple, 1/2 cup chopped nuts, 4 tablespoons cold water, 2 tablespoons lemon juice.

Softened gelatin in cold water then dissolve over boiling water. Beat whites until stiff, folding in sugar and salt. Carefully add fruits, nuts and lemon juice then add the gelatin gradually, stirring constantly. Pour into molds and chill.

Frozen Bread Pudding: 1 1/2 cups milk, 1/4 cup sugar, 1 tablespoon butter, 2 cups fine soft bread (crowd cups), 1 egg, 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg, 1 teaspoon vanilla, 1/2 cup seedless raisins.

Heat milk. Remove from range and add sugar, butter, bread and well beaten egg, then the flavoring. Cool and pour into freezing pans for two hours. Remove from pans and work in the raisins then return to the pans and freeze until well set (about two hours). Serve with cream or syrup.

Macaroon Bavarian: 2 cups milk, scalded, 1 pkg. cherry flavored gelatin, 1 cup whipping cream, 1 cup crushed macaroons, 1/4 cup chopped maraschino cherries.

Dissolve gelatin in scalded milk, add cherries and macaroons, mixing well. Cool until partially set then fold in whipped cream and turn into molds. Chill.

Grape Ice: 3 cups grape juice, 1/4 cup lemon juice, 2 cups water, 2-3 cup sugar.

Combine sugar and water, boil five minutes then cool. Add fruit juices and freeze.

Sliger Sherbet: 1 cup sugar, 2 cups water, 1 lb. canton ginger, 2-3 cup orange juice, 1-3 cup lemon juice, 1 egg white.

Boil sugar and water 15 minutes with ginger cut in small pieces. Add fruit juice, cool, strain and put in trays to freeze one hour. Remove and fold in beaten egg white. Return to freezing compartment to complete freezing.

Baked Alaska: This may be made as one large cake or in individual portions. Use a plain sponge cake for the bottom layer, having chilled it thoroughly before starting the final preparation. Place this cake (in portions) on a chilled board or several thicknesses of chilled brown paper. On the cake place a thick layer of ice cream. Cover with a heavy meringue. Place in oven at 425 degrees until slightly browned (about 15 minutes). Serve at once.

Cranberry Mousse: 2 1/2 cups cranberries, 1 1/4 cups cold water, 1 1/4 cups sugar, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1/4 cup orange juice, 1 1/4 teaspoon vanilla, 1 cup chilled evaporated milk (or whipping cream), 1/4 teaspoon gelatin.

Soak the evaporated milk and add one-half teaspoonful of gelatin which has been soaked in one teaspoon of cold water. Chill thoroughly and whip until stiff, before folding into the cranberry sauce (made of the first four ingredients cooked until tender, and strained). Add orange and vanilla. Mold and freeze about four hours.

MADISON, Wis., Dec. 7. — (AP) — Mrs. Helen Gillis, widow of "Baby Face" Nelson, was reported lodged in the Dane county jail today awaiting an appearance before Judge Patrick T. Stone in U. S. district court on charges of violating her probation. Incarceration in the jail would bring the widow back to the same tier of cells in which she and two other women were held incommunicado for several days after the raid on Little Bohemia resort near Eagle River last spring.

PAVEMENT REPAIR FOR MEDFORD ON NEXT STATE LIST

SALEM, Dec. 7. — (AP) — Awards for highway work aggregating about \$600,000 are to be let within the next two weeks, the state highway department announced here today. A letting in Portland tomorrow would amount to about \$350,000 and on December 20 another letting was estimated would reach \$250,000.

Call for bids on the latter letting was issued here today, work to be done on eight projects in six counties—Benton, Columbia, Washington, Jackson, Josephine and Lake counties. Bids to be opened tomorrow are on six projects in Coos, Douglas, Multnomah, Polk and Umatilla counties.

The new issue includes South Ashland section of Pacific highway, 1,100 lined feet of pavement widening and resurfacing, and the North Medford section of Pacific highway, 1.4 miles pavement resurfacing, Jackson county, Evelyn avenue-L street unit of Grants Pass section of Pacific highway, .94 mile pavement resurfacing in Josephine county.

Noted Scientist Taken By Death

BOSTON, Dec. 7. — (AP) — Dr. Allan Winter Rowe, international noted scientist, famed for researches in chemistry and biology, and director of research at the Evans Memorial hospital in Boston, died today. Dr. Rowe recently attracted wide attention when he announced before a convention of the American college of surgeons a treatment for childhood cancer which had been 50 per cent successful.

Portland Sewage Aid May Be Lost By Slow Action

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 7. — (AP) — Unless Portland does something about its proposed \$6,000,000 sewage disposal system for the city, and does it speedily, it will lose the \$2,240,000 which the federal government had promised as a gift. This was the word passed along by the FWA office here. The city replied that it will at once file action to test the validity of the \$6,000,000 bond issue voted last year for the sewage system.

REPORT BIRTH OF MISS STADELMAN

THE DALLIES, Dec. 7. — (Sp.) — Little Miss Stadelman, of this city, who has one grandfather eminent in each of the major political parties, also wins the distinction of having her birth the first reported in a campaign being carried out by the Oregon state board of health, the state emergency relief administration and the U. S. census bureau in co-operation.

In the mail today, bound for Washington, is a card filled out by George Stadelman, and Mrs. George Stadelman, daughter of Congressman Walter Pierce. When the managers of the campaign read in Portland of the birth of little Miss Stadelman, they immediately mailed to the parents a card, in advance of the sending of such cards to every family in the state. The cards provide for reporting every birth that has occurred in Oregon in the last 12 months.

Colonel Dreyfuss Not Seriously Ill

PARIS, Dec. 7. — (AP) — Col. Alfred Dreyfus, principal of the "Dreyfus case," celebrated episode of French history, was said today to be "very tired," but otherwise somewhat improved from an operation of two months ago. His home denied reports he was seriously ill at his country home in Brittany.
