### METHODISTS SUED ON BOND DEFAULT

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 14.—(AP)—The first suit to come to trial in nationwide litigation to collect \$3,000,000 in defaulted Methodist obligations, opened in federal court today.

William C. Bitting, Jr., St. Louis financier, is suing the Oregon conference of the Methodist church and Wesley hospital at Marshfield for a \$92,220 judgment on defaulted bond issue. Bitting, whose bond firm of Bitting & Co. has underwritten \$90,000,000 in religious obligations, has filed against a dozen or more Methodist institutions.
