HITTSON'S GOLD ILLEGALLY GAINED SAYS COURT PLEA

Portland papers the first of this week printed articles telling of Hittson's rich find, and the Oregonian editorially commented upon his good fortune in wresting a fortune from the hills.

The complaint alleges that "some time in 1934" Hittson "surreptitiously went, and did trespass on the Ruby mining claims, and without authority removed" gold ore to the value of \$18,300.

The First National bank is named as the agent of Hittson, in shipping the gold to the United States mint at San Francisco, and receiving cash payment in return.

It is further alleged that Hittson used a portion of the money thus received "to buy shares to secure control of the mining property and prevent the plaintiffs from participating in its affairs."

The Ruby mining claims, from which Hittson is asserted to have removed the gold, the complaint reveals, are located in the Elliot creek district, just over the California-Oregon state line, in Siskiyou county, California.

BOLIVIA DREDGE MANAGER GUEST AT FERRY HOME

Manager of the huge dredge for the recovery of tin 12,000 feet above sea level in the mountains of Bolivia, W. D. Adams and Mrs. Adams were visitors at the home of D. H. Ferry, manager of the gold dredge on Foothills creek near here yesterday.

The young couple will make their home here.

This is the first vacation in five years for the Adams', and after leaving Medford they intended going north to visit old friends they knew in Alaska who are now in Portland, Seattle and Vancouver.

In speaking of his mining operations in Bolivia, Mr. Adams stated that 100 men were employed in the work, most of them natives. It is difficult to procure labor in that country now because of the conscription to the army of most of the men in the war being waged between Bolivia and Paraguay.

The house servant situation is a bit rosy, however, he admitted, cooks and maids being obtainable for \$1.80 month. An expert gardener can be had for 8 cents a day. This situation is brought about by the devaluation of the Bolivian currency in relation to American money, our money now being worth six times what it was two or three years ago, Adams stated.

There is no native plant life at the high altitude where the dredge is located, so the mining company has had trees and flowers brought and transplanted, to convert what once was a barren camp into a charming place to live, the Adams' related.
