MINE LITIGATION CENTERS IN YREKA

Legal skirmishing in the suit filed a week ago, involving \$16,500 and title to the Ruby mining claims, in the Siskiyoue, is at present centered in the California courts. It is alleged that Hittson "surreptitiously" removed gold from the Ruby claim, and received the \$16,500 from the U. S. mint at San Francisco, in exchange.
