'SWELL WAR' WILL SWEEP WORLD IS WELLS PROPHECY

NEW YORK, March 9.-(AP)-E. O. Wells, re-echoing the prophecy of his book that another war would sweep the world, greeted America today with further comment that it would be a "swell war."

But war was a secondary topic with the British author. He was more concerned with Huey Long, Father Coughlin, depression cures and other American affairs.

Wells pleaded for time to study America before he committed himself. After all, he explained, he was here to "study England from the United States."

"Senator Long - I have an open opinion when he is concerned. Certainly I have no wish to insult his character, which seems to be a casual pastime in America. I know more about him after I'm here for three weeks. That is not an imputation. But I will say, from reports, the senator seems to be about 200 per cent American."
