ROGUE FLOOD SURVEY WOULD BE AUTHORIZED UNDER PENDING BILLS

WASHINGTON, March 13.—(AP)—Surveys of chief streams on the entire Oregon coast south of the Columbia river with a view of determining the best methods of controlling or eliminating floods which take a heavy damage toll each year, are provided for in seven bills before the house flood control committee...

Rep. Mott (R., Ore.) said the bills would provide for department surveys in all streams in Tillamook county, the Umpqua, Coquille, Rogue, Siskiyou, Yaquina and Silette rivers. The surveys Mott explained, would be the first step at controlling the flood waters which often sweep over rich agricultural lands...

The general appropriation of the war department for such purposes would cover the cost of the surveys. War department appropriations would provide funds, later, for necessary flood control work...

HARBOR SURVEYS GIVEN APPROVAL

WASHINGTON, March 13.—(AP)—The senate commerce committee has voted approval of bills by Senator Steiwer (R., Ore.) for surveys of the harbors of Chetco Cove, at Brookings, and Seaside, Ore. Steiwer said his bills would place the two harbors under the supervision of the board of army engineers. Chetco Cove, the senator said, is a natural deep water harbor and would provide an outlet for millions of feet of timber in southwestern Oregon. Very little work would be necessary to make it an excellent harbor, he said. The senator ultimately hopes to obtain improvements in both the Cove and Seaside harbors.
