

### DOCTORS ADDRESS BI-MONTHLY MEET OF HEALTH GROUP

Dr. Harvey Woods of Ashland, Dr. Dwight H. Findley and Dr. A. F. Walker Kresse were speakers at the bi-monthly meeting of the Jackson County Health Association yesterday afternoon at the court house auditorium. The meeting was attended by 45. Tea was served by the Gold Hill ladies, who were hostesses.

Taking as his subject the heart and its diseases, Dr. Woods gave an enlightening talk. He said that heart diseases have led the death rate since 1920 and are increasing in fatality rapidly, being responsible for one out of every five deaths.

He divided the study of the heart into three periods, the pre-scientific period, period of scientific investigation, and period of scientific application.

In reviewing the period of scientific investigation, Dr. Woods said Harvey was the first to prove circulation of blood, in an experiment with the body of a hanged man conducted in 1618. His report on this discovery is considered a classic today, Dr. Woods said.

The speaker gave modern unfavorable living conditions as the cause of the high death rate from heart diseases.

Dr. Findley's subject was sex education, in which he declared that an appalling situation exists, chiefly in the better class of families. He said that in most instances parents are to blame for lack of proper sex education among children. He advised parents to better inform themselves and to consult the family physician in sex problems just as in other health problems.

Dr. Kresse's subject was childhood problems. In an interesting view of the difficulties confronting the modern parent in properly rearing children, he said that fear is the greatest cause for misbehavior.

### GLAND FROM DEAD BOY AIDS IN DEVELOPMENT YOUNG DWARFED GIRL

ROSTOV, Russia — (UP) — Dwarf children may grow to normal height in the future as a result of an experiment by Prof. Nikolai Bogoraz of the Rostov Surgical Clinic.

Recently a girl, who appeared to be four years old, was brought to the clinic. Actually she was 11 and a pupil in the fourth grade. Her abnormal size was due to the underdevelopment of the hypophyse gland, an appendix of the brain, which influences growth.

Bogoraz took the hypophyse gland from the head of a young man who had died in an automobile accident an hour and a half earlier. He tested the blood of both bodies to determine their consanguinity than transferred the gland into the left shoulder artery of the dwarf girl.

Six months later the child had grown eight centimeters taller.

A second similar transfusion increased her height by six centimeters more. Her growth is still continuing.

Bogoraz was cautious in speaking of the results of his experiment, saying:

"From the broad viewpoint of medical science, of course, a few such successful experiments are not conclusive. But the experiment has exceptional importance."

### BACK TO THE LAND MOVE IS LAUNCHED

PORTLAND, Ore., March 22.—(AP)—A definite "back to the land movement" had been launched today by the new state emergency relief committee at its first meeting, and \$20,000 had been allocated for such rehabilitation work.

Action was taken late yesterday and the intent is to assist those on relief rolls in development of small tracts for self-help.

All members of the county judges' association of Oregon were asked to attend a conference with the relief committee to discuss methods of caring for indigents in all counties. The legislature appropriated \$1,000,000 for this work.

### STEWER AMENDMENT AIDS U. S. INDUSTRIES

WASHINGTON, March 22.—(AP)—The Stewer amendment to the public works bill, designed to protect industries of the United States, has been made a part of the senate bill.

The amendment provides that all material used in public works must be a product of the United States. Senator Stewer (R., Ore.) said it was designed, especially, to protect the lumber industry from foreign competition.
