

FEW ATTENDING O. S. C. PAY FIVE DOLLAR FEE IN SPITE OF PROGRAM

CORVALLIS, March 28.—(AP)—A plea for payment of the \$5 student association fee at Oregon State college had resulted last night in the collection of the \$5 from only 408 of the 2,254 enrolled students. It was the fourth day of the collection campaign.

Unless more than twice this number of students participate it is feared the present program extra-curricular activity must be abandoned. C. V. Rurek, chairman of the board of control, said shortage of the associated student organization funds the first two terms was \$10,000 and the estimated shortage for the whole year will be \$18,500.

Dr. George W. Peavy, president of the college, told a meeting of 680 students here yesterday that "there are definitely two sides of a student's education. One is the learning acquired from books, classroom work; the other comes from participation in student activities which teaches students how to live with their fellows."

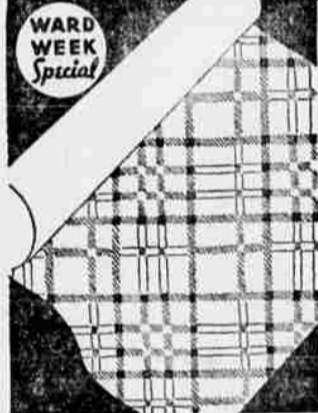
