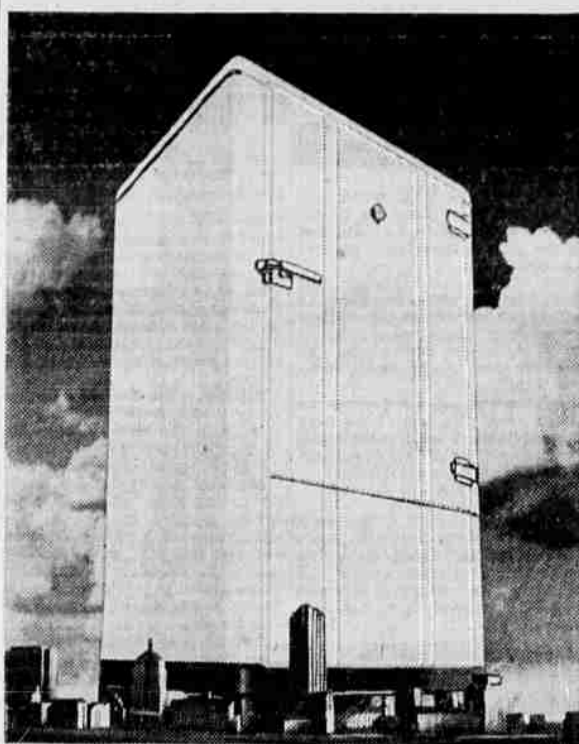


VOCATIONAL CLUB HAS OPENING FOR MORE YOUNG MEN
