'BABY FACE'S' AIDE SAID FRISCO 'HOT', URGED HILL TRIP

SAN FRANCISCO, March 30.—(AP)—The blood-stained trail of George ("Baby Face") Nelson was traced farther by government witnesses here today in the federal court trial of nine persons for harboring the notorious Dillinger gangster in his flight from justice.

place in San Francisco were told by William Ramsay, department of justice agent, who said the fugitive gangster finally decided the city was "too hot" and fled eastward to his death in Illinois.

Ramsay was testifying concerning a purported confession by Anthony ("Soap") Moreno, San Francisco bartender and one of the nine defendants.

Moreno was quoted by the witness as admitting that he was approached here last year by Nelson and John Paul Chase, sentenced to life imprisonment at Chicago for his part in the Barrington, Ill., battle with federal men.

"Nelson and Chase wanted Moreno to find them a hideout in San Francisco," Ramsay testified, "but he demurred." The agent said that at another meeting Moreno warned the two gangsters "they were too hot for the town" and suggested they flee into northern California's hills.

NARCOTIC SUPPLY AND 'HOT SHOT' OF TRAFFIC NABBED

NEW YORK, March 30.—(AP)—A "who's who" of the narcotics traffic was in the hands of federal agents tonight following the arrest of a man they described as one of the largest wholesale distributors ever apprehended.

The book was said by one agent to contain the names of customers in the Hollywood film colony, but Frank Igo, chief of the local narcotics squad, declared it listed only the names and addresses of dealers.

Following a clue that originated in Sacramento, Cal., the government men arrested Barney Price, 38, whom they described as a "front man" for a ring that had its source of supply in Italy and made regular shipments to Chicago, Los Angeles, Portland, Ore., Tampa, Fla., and other cities.

Robert Primrose, dapper Broadway expert of the narcotics squad who helped lay the trap, declared Price tried to evade arrest by bolting for a second floor window but was halted.

Taken into custody with Price was Eugene Stan, 20, who drove his car to the midtown hotel where the trap was laid. Both were charged with violating the Harrison narcotic act after agents said they had found narcotics valued at \$28,000 on Price's person and at his home.

ICKES' OBJECTION TO RELIEF BILL THREATENS DELAY

WASHINGTON, Mar. 30.—(AP)—Congress was in recess today but legislators and officials kept busy with committee hearings, labor troubles, NRA and the relief bill.

Secretary Ickes' objection to an amendment inserted by conferees on the work relief bill was transmitted directly to the president aboard his yacht in Bahama waters, and threatened to delay the measure once again.

The controverted amendment would require a direct expenditure for labor of \$300,000,000 of the \$900,000,000 tentatively allocated for construction loan and grants to municipalities and states. This would prevent, some officials said, any loans for municipal light plants and similar construction.

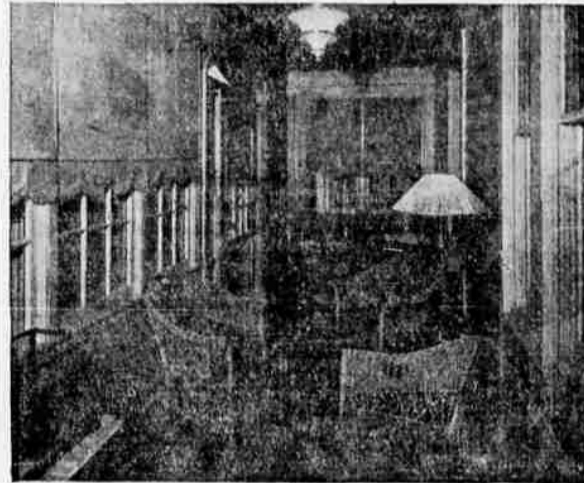
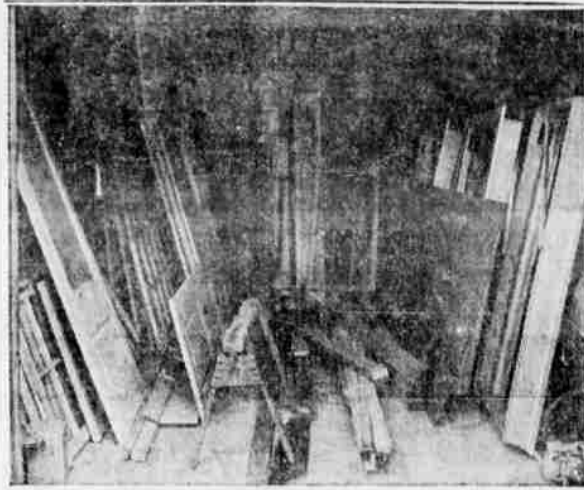
Unless the president intervened, however, the expectation was that the clause would remain in the long pending measure.

Mrs. Hart's recipe follows: 2 slices of Premium bacon, sliced; 2 tablespoons of flour; 1 cupful of milk; 1 No. 2 can of early garden peas; 1/4 teaspoonful of salt; Dash of pepper.

Brown the diced bacon in a skillet or saucepan then add the flour and smooth to a paste. Add the milk and cook, stirring occasionally until a smooth, sauce is formed. Add the peas, including the liquid, season to taste with salt and pepper and continue stirring until slightly thickened and sufficiently cooked. Serve on hot

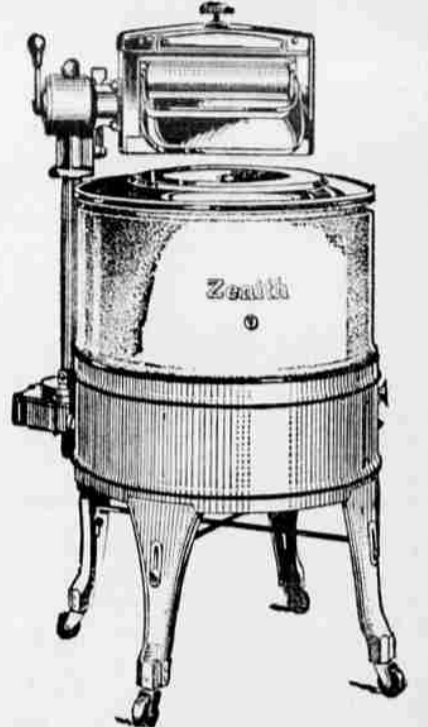
buttered toast or as a regular vegetable dish. Serves four to six. I began serving peas in this fashion when it was inconvenient to make gravy. My family like the dish
