CROP AND FEED LOAN BLANKS AVAILABLE AT AGENT'S OFFICE NOW

Emergency crop and feed loan blanks are now available in Jackson county at the offices of R. O. Fowler, county agent, Medford...

Only those farmers who are unable to qualify either directly or through their landlords for a loan from a Production Credit association are eligible for Emergency Crop or Feed loans.

Two types of loans are available: 1. A crop loan; a first mortgage on the crops is required. 2. A feed loan for the purchase or production of feed for livestock; a first mortgage on the livestock is required.

1. The Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Co. valuation and rate case will be pushed through circuit court in Portland as rapidly as possible.

2. The Northwestern power case, involving the so-called Electric Bond & Share Companies, will similarly be pushed to an early court determination.

3. The Mountain States Power Co. investigation, nearly completed, will be finished. A public hearing on rates and valuations will be held and an order probably issued early this summer by the utilities commissioner.
