Two Types Taxes The measure now levies two types of taxes on payrolls: one for contributory old-age annuities and one for unemployment insurance.

Peak in 1949 Thus, they calculated, the total tax burden would be \$200,000,000 in 1936, rising to \$800,000,000 in 1937, to \$1,000,000,000 in 1938, to \$1,200,000,000 in 1940, to \$1,400,000,000 in 1943, to \$1,500,000,000 in 1946 and to a \$1,800,000,000 maximum in 1949.

FRAZIER INHERITANCE TAX HEARING SLATED

An order setting April 11 as time for a hearing on the state inheritance tax, to be affixed to the estate of the late Frank D.
