

FAVORS CAPITOL ON WILLAMETTE CAMPUS

MARSHFIELD, Ore., May 17.—(AP) Construction of a new state capitol building on the present site of Willamette university at Salem was advocated here today by Senator John D. Gow.

Gow's plan, which he proposed as purely tentative but at least worthy of study, would move Willamette university to a location "where there would be ample grounds for a dignified campus with room for all campus activity." He believes the project could be financed by federal aid, either independently or in participation with the state.

SALAD SEASONABLES

All about us the trees are blooming with promises of fresh fruits before many weeks. The "garden spots" of home, and those of our markets, are becoming more versatile and interesting every day and, in the same proportion, salad ideas are presenting themselves for spring consumption. So, the Salad Bowl takes the center of the table again!

May Basket Salads
Cut baskets from grapefruit and

remove pulp carefully. These may then be cooked in water until tender and then put into a heavy syrup and recooked at 220 degrees, drained and sprinkled with granulated sugar. Of course, such baskets would be for special occasions and filled with long keeping fruits. However, for more ordinary service, just fill the freshly cut baskets with a good fruit combination, top with whipped cream and serve on a lace paper dolly at each place.

Florida Salad

Each serving:
1/2 avocado.
1/2 cup crab meat.
1/2 teaspoon salt.
1/4 cup sour cream dressing.

Have ingredients very cold and fill the avocado with the crab meat and dressing. Garnish with red and green peppers or some such decoration.
Dressing: Mix and chill:

1/4 cup sour cream.
1 teaspoon lemon juice.
1/2 teaspoon vinegar.
1/2 teaspoon salt.
Dash cayenne pepper.

Spring Surprise salad
1 large cucumber.
2 stuffed olives.
1 pkg. lemon flavored gelatin.
3 tomatoes.
2 cups boiling water.
1 head lettuce.
Mayonnaise.

Dissolve the gelatin in boiling water and fill individual molds (or muffin tins, one-third full). When they are firm, decorate with thinly sliced olives and cucumber and add just enough gelatin to hold the decoration then return to the refrigerator.

Remove skins from the tomatoes and slice in one-inch size. Spread with mayonnaise and place on salad plate, mayonnaise side down. Un-

mold gelatin mixture and place on top of slice of tomato then completely cover the salad with mayonnaise and shredded lettuce. Garnish with a stuffed olive or radish rose.

Apple Blossom Salad
1 cup steamed prunes (pit and chill).
1 cup orange pulp, diced.
1 cup apples, diced.
1 cup dates, chopped.
1/2 cup orange juice.

Put into a salad bowl lined with lettuce leaves, covering the diced fruit with the prunes. Make blossoms of pink marshmallows, cutting with scissors to simulate apple blossoms. Use a tiny yellow candy in the center of each flower.

Stuffed Beet Salad
Cook medium sized beets until tender, remove skins and center portion of each. Place on bed of shredded

lettuce and fill with a mixture of celery, green onions, radishes, etc. Dress with French dressing and serve very cold.

CAT PIED PIPER HAS RAT RECORD

SHELBY, O.—(UP)—This city lays claim to a feline "Pied Piper" which during the last five years has killed an estimated 2,000 rats.

His name is "Pal" and he is a five-year-old cat belonging to Arthur Allwine, barber shop proprietor. Little is known of Pal's lineage, but he is mostly tiger, with a bit of Angora, which accounts for the fact that he has attained a weight of 17 pounds.

"Since the time he was a kitten I've kept track of the rats he's killed. I couldn't tell exactly the number he's hunted down, but according to my estimated figures, its around 2,000," Allwine said.

His average has been two or three a day, or about six or eight a week. "He eats them all, too. No milk diet for him. Except for a dime's worth of hamburger once a week, he seems to want no other food," Allwine said. "On Saturday, though, he wants his hamburger. It may sound like an exaggeration but on Saturday evening he comes into the shop and won't give me any peace until I buy the meat for him."

Pal also, unlike other cats, has a fondness for small dogs. He was raised with a small terrier.
