

FLANDIN DEFEATED IN AIM TO DICTATE FRENCH FINANCES

PARIS, May 30.—(AP)—The finance committee of the chamber of deputies turned against Premier Pierre-Etienne Flandin today in his demand for dictatorial financial powers over France and voted against his bill, 25 to 15.

Undeterred, however, by this opposition, the premier said he would carry his appeal direct to the chamber tomorrow.

Further carrying out the government's project of defending the franc against devaluation, Flandin said the prosecution of speculators was contemplated and that evidence already gathered had been transmitted to the ministry of justice.

OTTAWA, May 30.—(AP)—Premier R. B. Bennett today announced that the government would introduce legislation in the house this week or next empowering it to revalue gold.

MORE OREGONIANS GO BACK TO JOBS

SAN FRANCISCO, May 30.—(AP)—Oregon employment increased about 9 per cent in April over March, the federal reserve bank of San Francisco reported today, after a survey of 114 firms. The rise was said to be less than seasonal.

Payrolls were up 7 per cent—about the seasonal amount. Average weekly wages increased 4 per cent.

The bank's index of employment stood at 72 per cent of the 1923-1925 average, a rise from 70 in March, and even with April last year. Adjusted for seasonal variation, the index stood at 74, compared with the March adjusted index of 73, and with 74 in April, 1934.

CLAIMS REDFERN ALIVE IN JUNGLE

COLON, Panama, May 30.—(AP)—An amazing account of finding Paul Redfern, American aviator who disappeared eight years ago, living as a "medicine man" in the jungle of Dutch Guiana was related today by Tom Roche.

The informant, a German-born American citizen, said he lived for three months in 1933 with Redfern, who vanished while on a flight from Brunswick, Ga., to Rio de Janeiro.

Roche previously had told his story to James L. Park, U. S. consul here, and Park relayed to the state department at Washington the narrator's offer to lead a rescue expedition to Redfern's hut in an Indian village far from civilization.

Roche said Redfern was critically injured when his plane crashed against a mountain. Indians who found the aviator with both legs and his left arm broken nursed the flier back to health, he said.

SMOKING DAVENPORT EMPTIES APARTMENTS

PORTLAND, Ore., May 30.—(AP)—Smoke from a smoldering davenport drove 30 tenants of the Arbor court apartments into the street at 12:10 a. m. today.

Damage was reported at \$200. Miss Zoe Brooks, occupant of the apartment in which the fire began, did not awaken until the dense smoke made it necessary for another tenant, E. A. Dickinson, to lead her to safety.

NEW CURRENCY FOR FARM FINANCE AIM

WASHINGTON, May 30.—(AP)—Decried by the supreme court in their effort to provide a mortgage moratorium for farmers, Senators Praxler and Representative Lusk of North Dakota today pressed for passage of a bill to provide \$2,000,000,000 of new currency to refinance farm debts.

Lusk expressed confidence of getting sufficient signatures on a petition to force house consideration of the legislation.

DEBT CERTIFICATES ISSUED FOR RELIEF

SALEM, May 30.—(AP)—Certificates of indebtedness amounting to \$200,000 was issued today as of June 1 by the state treasurer for relief purposes. The certificates are issued against the anticipated revenue of the state liquor control commission.

With this issue the state has outstanding \$900,000 in certificates against the fund all issued during the current year. None of the certificates have been taken up since January 3.


