RASPBERRY CROP SHORT THIS YEAR

PORTLAND, June 6.—(AP)—The greatest shortage of raspberries ever indicated in the Pacific northwest total crop is due this year, according to reports of growers in the Pacific northwest. The shortage promises to be most acute in the Pierce county, Washington territory. For that section reports current suggested less than half the normal crop in fact some forecasts are for but a third to a quarter of the normal showing.
