

CHURCHES UNITE IN BIBLE SCHOOL OPENING MONDAY

A combined vacation Bible school under the joint sponsorship of the Presbyterian and Methodist churches is to open its first session, Monday, 9 a. m.

The school is to be of two weeks duration and under direction of Don Huckabee, Mr. Huckabee, working in co-operation with Rev. Peterson of the Presbyterian church, and Rev. Knotts of the Methodist church, has prepared an extremely interesting and valuable program for the boys and girls who attend.

The vacation school will offer work in the following fields:
A course in "Learning about our Christ." A helpful and entertaining study of the meaning of church forms and equipment. The class is to be under direction of Rev. Peterson. The work will be in the form of a daily worship service conducted by and with the children.

For the children, a study of "God and the Beautiful." A good treatment of a worthwhile thought. The course will introduce to the children the best in music, art, and Nature; and will strive to bring about an appreciation based on an understanding of the thoughts in the minds of the creators. This course will be given by Mrs. English of the Girls' Community club.

Several courses in Bible study for the younger children. These courses will deal with the adventure stories of the Old and New Testaments and will be taught through the use of the Hero story and Free Drama.

In addition to the above, there will be organized recreation and drama under the supervision of competent directors.

At the conclusion of the school there will be a picnic for the students and a graduation exercise with a display of the handiwork and accomplishments of the children.
