## PILOT DESCENDS IN CLEARING AT RANGER STATION

ROSEBURG, Ore., June 14.—(AP)—Flying off his course and with his fuel supply running low, F. H. Barnes of Escalon, California, set his sport monoplane down yesterday on the pasture at the Big Camas ranger station in the heart of the Umpqua national forest. It was the first airplane landing ever made in the rugged north Umpqua basin.

Barnes, flying from Granta Pass to Roseburg, mistook his directions at Canyonville, flying up the South Umpqua river instead of following down the stream into Roseburg.

The mistake took him into the heart of the forest, where he was forced to seek a landing.

He circled the pasture at the ranger station, the only cleared spot in the area, and made a safe landing. The right landing wheel, however, was damaged as it struck an ant hill while the plane was being taxied.

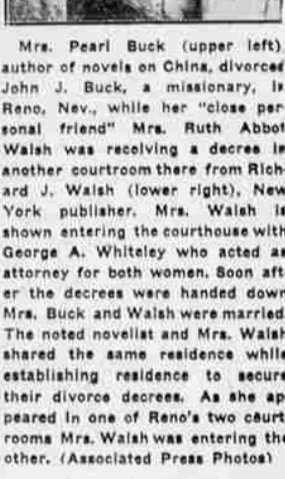
## JUDGE AND JURY WEAR GOGGLES DURING TRIAL

KANSAS CITY, Mo.—(UP)—The dust storms this spring reached as far east as Kansas City a time or two, but apparently the city folk only got a taste of what became "usual weather" in the western part of Kansas. Merle A. Gill, ballisticsian, called to Tribune, Kan., to testify in a murder case, told about his experiences.

## \$1365 SHOTGUN IS USED IN COMPETING AT PIGEON TOURNEY

The famous shotgun that won the international live bird championship for E. W. (Ted) Renfro at Monte Carlo in 1931 may be seen at the trap tournament at the Medford Gun Club, Mr. Renfro plans to use the gun in the Medford handicap, scheduled for tomorrow.

The gun cost Mr. Renfro \$1,365 but he considers it worth the price for it brought him top prize of \$20,000 at the Monte Carlo meet.

It was made by the Merkel Brothers, famous German craftsmen, and every last piece of it was made by hand. It functions with smooth precision perfect that there is not a bit of stiffness. All of the interior mechanism is gold plated.

The gun was also engraved by hand by the Merkel artists, the scroll work being done with meticulous attention to details. It has an over and under barrel, a characteristic that distinguishes it from most shot guns which have parallel barrels.

The gun is going to be passed on down in a few years by Mr. Renfro to his nine-year-old son, E. W. Junior, who already has his name engraved upon it, the work of W. A. Crum who is here to do similar work for the sportsmen competing in the Medford tournament. The junior Renfro already handles a rifle and soon will be demanding a shotgun, said his father.

## COLORED GIANTS TO PLAY ROGUES HERE JUNE 22ND

That Medford will soon have the opportunity to witness one of the fastest baseball teams in the independent circuit was the assurance given this afternoon by Manager "Hoosier" Hoffer of the Medford Rogues, who has just completed arrangements to have the Detroit Colored Giants appear at the fairgrounds here on Saturday, June 22.

Hoffer has been dickering with the Giants for some time, but has had some difficulty in meeting their payment guarantee. The Detroit Giants have never before appeared here, and Manager Hoffer believes that the game will draw well. He has not yet decided on whether the game will be held in the afternoon or in the evening, but stated that an effort to install lights at the grounds for the occasion is now being made.

Since installation of lights entails considerable expense, he has not yet fully decided upon their use, but intends waiting until he has a better indication of the crowd he may expect.

Hoffer also announced today that he is bidding for a pitcher from the Timber League, but declined to state who the chucker would be, confining his statement to a brief "He will be better than anyone in the Southern Oregon league now. His contract will expire up there in a few days. At that time I'll have more to say on the subject."
