

# LAWSON TO FACE SEVERE TEST ON BLEAK MUIRFIELD

### British Open Will Be Played Over Hazard-Studded Course in Scotland—Versatility Will Aid Chance

LONDON—(AP)—Lawson, Little, successor to Bobby Jones as major domo of the world's amateur golfers, will need all his great skill and every one of his 22 clubs to win the British open at Muirfield, next objective in his phenomenal two-year career.

The 72-hole grind over Scotland's bleakest links on the Firth of Forth will find the California bomber opposed to the world's leading professional stars including Henry Cotton and Gene Sarazen, on a course that hitherto has proved far too tough for any amateur to disturb the ranks of the money players.

The last British open played at Muirfield, in 1929, was won by Walter Hagen with a four-round total of 292. He had a margin of six strokes over the runner-up, Johnny Farrell. Cyril Tolley won the amateur medal with a score of 312, or an average of 78 strokes to the round.

To present even a better idea of the hazards to be encountered at Muirfield, where the winds blow a constant gale and the traps are so deep and steep they have to be waded with planking: In six opens played there since 1892 the average winning score has been 303! Cotton won last year at Sandwich with 282, a record shared with Sarazen.

Here's Hightower's side of the picture for Little. On the fairer side is the honest impression of a half-dozen of England's leading critics and players, expressed to the writer, that Muirfield is "made for Little." They say he will eat it up at the end of the tournament he hailed honestly in England as "another Bobby Jones."

Muirfield is long and heavily-trapped, but a paradise for a golfer who can hit his drives a mile down the middle and control his iron shots in the wind. Little, as he proved at St. Anne's, can do both when he is shooting for keeps. He comes nearer than any amateur to dominating Hagen's low, wind-defying iron. It was amazing at St. Anne's to note the difference between the trajectory of Little's irons and those of his British opponents.

Another bit of equipment that will stand at Muirfield is his ability to explode from bunkers. There is no such thing as chipping or rolling out of the average British sand pit. The ball has to be exploded almost perpendicularly, oftentimes as high as eight or ten feet, and any player who can't play such a shot and stop it dead when it hits the green is out of luck. Little is one amateur who can. Consequently, he should not have any chance-running eighth and tens on his card, while some of the professionals will.

Uses Variety of Sticks.  
The extreme versatility of Little's game is best illustrated by the fact that he used all but five of his 22 clubs at St. Anne's. He carries two extra drivers since he carried one in last year's American amateur, and a couple of extra mashies. He has wedges and peculiar clubs in his bag that he might use only once a tournament, but he knows when to use them, and how.

If it all comes back to his putting. If he is getting them down at Muirfield—look out Sarazen, Cotton, et al! If not, he may have difficulty qualifying for the last two days. Whatever happens, he will go on putting in his own way, waiting for them to start dropping. His game satisfies him as it is, and he can't be stampeded into experimenting.

On one particular round of the amateur he had putted miserably, taking three strokes on about every third hole and sinking nothing longer than six inches. Afterwards he was out practicing, knocking ball after ball at the hole that still eluded him Jack McLean, Scottish star, watched him earnestly for a few moments and then offered a suggestion.

"Thanks," said Little, "but that would be changing my whole system."

And he went on knocking them at the hole and missing.
