When "Pop" Takes A Holiday How About "Mom"?

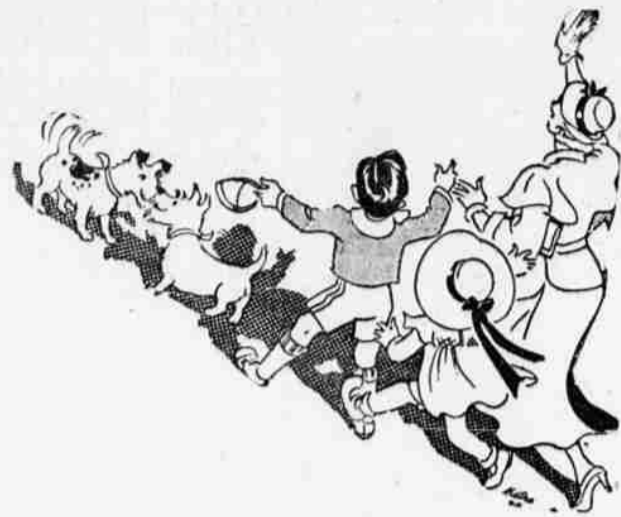
