Thousands of Relief Families Raise Supply of Garden Foods This Season



SELF-AID EFFORT TO PRODUCE HUGE SUPPLY OF FOOD Multnomah leads Oregon's 46 counties in the number of substance gardens planted this year through the sponsorship of the state relief committee, with almost 7,000 planned. It is figured that already in the state 20,000 gardens have been planted by families on relief rolls, and it is expected this total will hit 25,000 or 30,000 before the summer is far spent. Multnomah is the next highest garden program planted, with 2,301, then Lane with 1,480, and Clatsop with 1,407, according to April figures just compiled. The May and June figures will run this total, it is estimated, to 30,000 gardens, which will make the Oregon relief sabbary program also much larger and of more benefit than last year, and of more benefit to the state. The fact that weather conditions have made everything almost a month later this year, will mean that many gardens will be planted, cultivated and harvested in late summer and fall. One of the rulings of the federal relief administration this year is that every family on relief shall plant, cultivate and harvest a subsistence garden in the effort to cut down the amount of food commodities that Uncle Sam has been called upon to furnish.
