State Senator James A. Hazlett said that press reports from Washington indicated that the Bonneville bill introduced by Senators McNary and Steiwer would provide for immediate construction of transmission lines to Portland and Vancouver, Wash., but not to The Dalles.

Transmission lines could be built to any section which made showing to the federal power commission that the project would be economically

justifiable, Hazlett said he understood.

However, he favored an amendment incorporated in a house Bonneville bill by Congressman Pierce, providing that the power commission could build transmission lines to The Dalles or other sections without guarantee of economic justification within a certain prescribed time.

Copies of the bills were awaited here eagerly. Ralph B. Bennett, chairman of the power committee of the local chamber of commerce, called a meeting of his group tomorrow night to consider the situation.

**COMPROMISE NEAR CANADA WHISKEY SMUGGLING SUIT**

SEATTLE (UP)—The federal government has agreed to compromise

its \$17,250,000 tax suit against the Reifel liquor interests of Vancouver, B. C., for \$500,000.

The case was to have gone to trial in federal court after two postponements.

Sam Whitaker, special assistant U. S. attorney general, announced that Joseph Keenan, assistant U. S. attorney general at Washington, had wired the government's acceptance of the half-million dollar settlement.

The suit was brought to collect customs, duties, penalties and internal revenue taxes for huge quantities of liquor allegedly smuggled into the

United States from Canada during prohibition.

It was believed criminal indictments against Henry Reifel and his son George, charging conspiracy to smuggle liquor into the United States, would be dropped.

The government will collect a total of \$700,000 in the case. Reifel and his son forfeited \$100,000 bail each several months ago when they failed to appear to answer the criminal charges.

Federal court was expected to dismiss the civil suit tomorrow.

The settlement with the Reifels

was without prejudice in all courts. It contemplates a complete release and satisfaction of all tax claims, not only against the defendants but against Brewers and Distillers, Ltd., and subsidiaries which have thousands of stockholders in the United States. Defense Attorney Donald G. Eggerman said.
