Planning the fall wardrobe in preparation for a return to school or college soon will be occupying the minds of mothers and daughters, yet with so many decidedly smart back-to-school styles being shown in the market, one should find it comparatively easy to select desirable and practical outfits for school, campus and dressy wear.

Plaids are especially favored in youthful fashions for fall and winter, in some cases appearing as trimming accents or in combination with velvet or velveteen—in others the plaid fabric is used throughout to fashion

the entire frock or coat.

Among the smartest frocks in this category, the one sketched here, using novelty plaid woolen, is very effective in gray, yellow and white color combination—very tailored and sporty looking with its pointed collar and chamamo colored ascot scarf.

The handling of the plaid pattern is very important, too, as indicated in this model. For the back yoke, the plaid pattern follows the V-shaped design, the remainder of the back bodice using the pattern straight, and for the front bodice, sleeves and skirt, the plaid stripes run diagonally across.

The sleeves are long, with buttoned cuffs and braided frogs of chamamo wool attractively ornament the bodice and belt.

Boisne Paris makes a cocktail dress in midnight blue which carries out this fashion feature. The corsage and skirt are of loose, unpressed pleats, stitched only at the waist which is belted in bright red. A separate jacket fastens at the nape of the neck with a rosette of a composition material. The red rosette repeats the bright color tone of the belt.

At the Karanouchka night club at Vichy, another chic visitor was dressed in silk in a Dresden pattern. The gown was built up high at the neck with an upstanding ruff of the material circling the throat. It was belted with a stiff taffeta in a bright cerise shade which tied in a large bow in back.

**MELON AND TOMATO
PACT WAITS LOWER
PRICES ON PRODUCT**

The enforcement organization of the Oregon melon and tomato marketing agreement is perfected and ready to take the field on very short notice, according to Morton Tomp-

kins of Dayton, and Wesley Williams of Roseburg, executives of the agreement.

However, they stated there are reports to the effect that there is a crop shortage of some commodities covered by the marketing agreement, and the organization will not become effective until such time as the market price of melons or tomatoes falls below the minimums as set by the agreement. When this occurs, an enforcement organization will be placed in the territory within three days. If prices do not drop to those levels, growers will not have the additional expense of enforcement.

The producers of those commodities are requested to keep the Portland office of the agreement informed as to marketing conditions and their effect on the prices re-

ceived because action of the executive committee will be guided almost entirely by wishes of the producers.

Guayaquil, one of Ecuador's most important cities, was founded by Benalcazar in 1535.

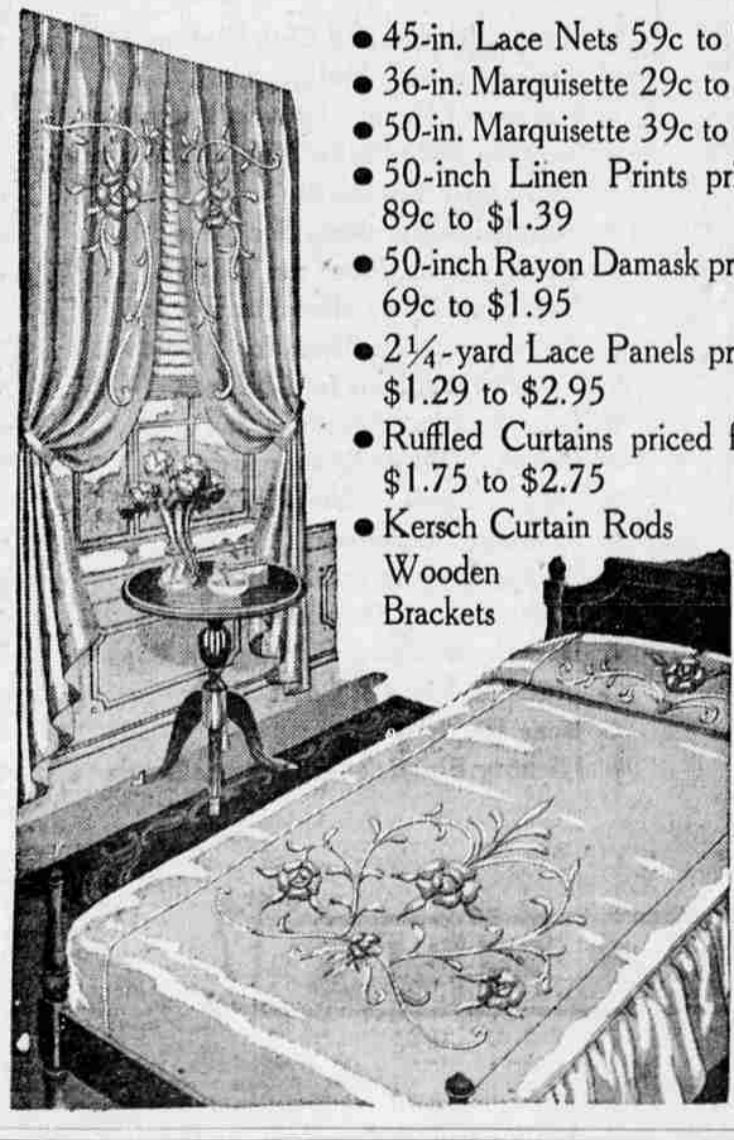
