Application for the completion of rural road oiling on the program inaugurated last year, in which 10 miles of road is to be oiled every year for five years.

A delegation of Central Point business men interviewed Hockley and discussed plans for the installation of a sewage treatment plant in that city. Talent representatives also indicated plans for a new sewage plant and system, as did the city of Ashland. Representatives from Butte Falls and Phoenix also spoke to Hockley, but stated that they did not have any particularly pressing need for government projects now.

The city of Medford also indicated a desire to secure a grant for a new storage reservoir here at an unannounced cost.

For administrative expenses the bill would allot \$1,000,000 for the new social security board, \$200,000 to the children's bureau, \$1,000,000 to the public health service and \$16,500 to the office of education.

It would appropriate \$245,000 for the national labor relations board, \$1,250,000 with which the interstate commerce commission would regulate buses and trucks under newly-enacted law, and the balance for small miscellaneous items.

In the ten years ending with December, 1934, forest fires in Oregon have burned more than 1,880,000 acres; an average of 188,000 acres of forest land or a strip of land 50 miles long and six miles wide. Careless campers and smokers caused most of these fires.

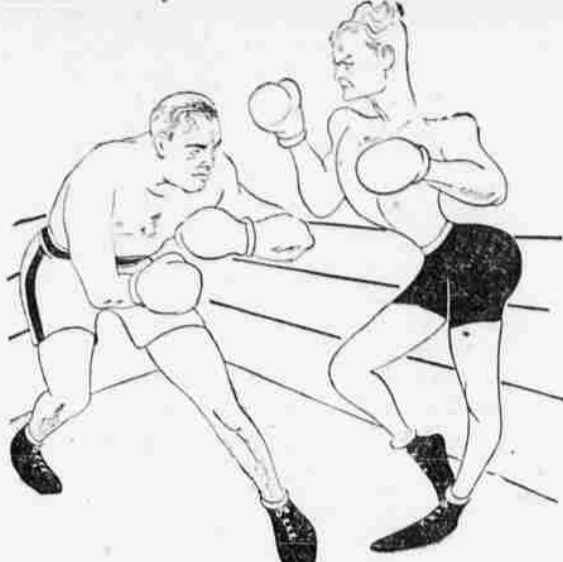
