WASHINGTON, Aug. 27.—(AP)—Turbulent and tense to the very last instant of its strife-torn first session, the 74th congress headed homeward today leaving anxious Roosevelt leaders seeking ways to obtain millions in funds cut off by a 8 1/2 hour filibuster by Senator Long (D-La.)
