

WHEAT PRICES SOAR IN WORLD MARKETS ACCOUNT WAR TALK

CHICAGO, Sept. 19.—(AP)—War skyrocketing of wheat prices today outdid in some world markets any heights reached in the last five years.

All current offerings of wheat for shipment to Europe were reported as having been accepted virtually regardless of cost.

Wheat closed nervous, 2 1/2% above yesterday's finish, Dec. \$1.00 1/4; corn, 1/2 off to 1/4 up, Dec. \$0.75 1/8; oats 1/4-3/8 up, and provisions varying from 12 cents setback to an advance of 22 cents.

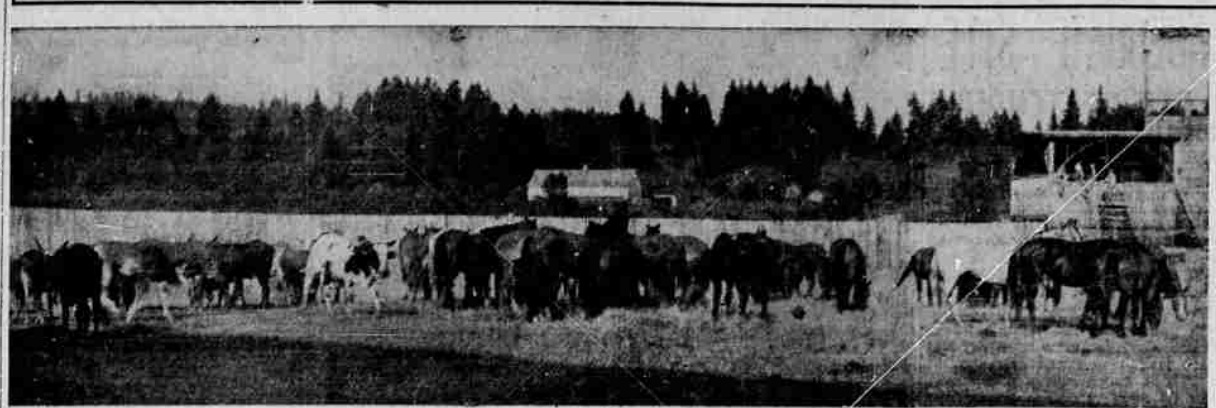
