

SPECIAL POLL ON RESERVOIR UP OCTOBER 26

1938 when a bond issue of \$146,000 would be retired.

Construction of a new reservoir was brought forward at this particular time because of a federal grant of \$250,000 toward the estimated cost of \$145,000 for the proposed plant. In making the grant the PWA specified that the gift would be cancelled unless the citizens of Medford voted on the proposition before November 1 and the actual work was started not later than December 15.

Self Liquidating
Mr. White told the council that the proposed reservoir would be self liquidating, the bond issue to be serviced from water revenues. The financing involved no additional tax levies, he emphasized, though he stated that the proposed project would extend "for a while longer" the present water rates. He added, however, that the present rates would be continued for a time anyway if the water board's intention of a bonding with the reservoir after 1938 were carried out so that there would be no lowering of rates in the immediate future.

Mayor George W. Porter pointed out that in submitting the proposition to a public vote the council was not committing itself as being in approval of the proposed reservoir. The council was remaining neutral, he said, and was only passing on the proposal to the voters for them to decide for themselves whether or not they want to authorize the construction of the reservoir.

Mr. White said the water board believes the reservoir is a pressing necessity and feels that construction should be undertaken now when a large share of the cost will be borne by the national government and not postponed a couple of years when the city would have to bear the entire expense. He indicated that the board is also contemplating the sale of water outside the city but before that is done a greater reserve supply is needed. It was stressed, too, that additional storage facilities are needed to guarantee an adequate supply of water for the city under all conditions.

Capacity 10,000,000 Gallons
The two present reservoirs have a combined capacity of 4,000,000 gallons and the proposed reservoir would have a capacity of 10,000,000 gallons, it was explained.

It was explained that the voters some time ago authorized the water commission to float a bond issue of \$50,000 but that the bonds have never been sold so that, in effect, an additional issue of only \$30,000 would be voted upon at the election October 26.

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GORE FORECLOSURE SUIT FEDERAL COURT NEXT SESSION HERE

Arguments on legal procedure seeking to give to William H. Gore, beneficiary under the revised Frazier-Lemke farm act, will be heard in federal court here, during the Southern Oregon district term, scheduled to start October 15. The motion is tentatively set for early hearing. Attorneys George M. Roberts and William McAllister, counsel for Gore, report.

Gore applied for relief under the original Frazier-Lemke act, declared unconstitutional by a United States supreme court decision. The act was remodelled and passed by the last session of congress. Gore now seeks re-instatement under the new act.

Under a ruling handed down this week in circuit court by Judge H. D. Norton, Gore is given possession of the farm property on litigation and a foreclosure sale in favor of the California Joint Stock and Land Bank is set aside, pending a re-sale. The bank, in the ruling, is also denied a deficiency judgment.

The ruling, made in view of recent supreme court decisions, in effect provides that the farm property shall not be sold at less than normal value. Gore, contended that the amount of the Joint Bank mortgages of approximately \$80,000 represented half the normal value.

The property in litigation is the Gore ranch on the Jacksonville-Ruch highway. It is an agricultural landmark of Jackson county and southern Oregon.

110 REPORTED KILLED
BY CHINESE PIRATES

HONGKONG, China, Oct. 4.—(AP)—Pirate attacks on the two river launches in Kwangtung province, resulting in the death of an estimated 110 persons, were reported here today.

At Sheklung, the report said pirates fired on a motor launch, panicking passengers into leaping overboard. It is believed 100 perished.

The bandits poured rifle fire on the boats from shore positions, leading to suspicion they are arson racketeers.

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
