Hunting Don'ts

- With the deer season now in full swing, the upland bird shooting starting on Sunday, and the migratory bird season starting on October 21, the following "don'ts" listed by the Oregon State Game commission will prove of exceptional interest.

It is Always Unlawful To hunt or kill white tail deer. To hunt or kill sage hens. To trap or kill beaver. To hunt at night. To hunt on any game refuge. To hunt deer with dogs. To waste game wantonly. To sell plumage of game or song birds.

To use a light of any kind in hunting any of the game animals or game birds of the state of Oregon. To hunt, pursue, molest, catch, kill or destroy any game animals or game birds from an automobile, power-propelled vehicle, or other mechanical conveyance.
