For the week ended Oct. 18, gold received at New York totalled \$116,028,000, the largest for any week since early in 1934, when tentative stabilization of the dollar just under 60 per cent of its old parity brought a record-breaking influx. Of that total, \$89,946,000 came from France.

A light signal drill today, following yesterday's bruising workout, completed preparations for the game.

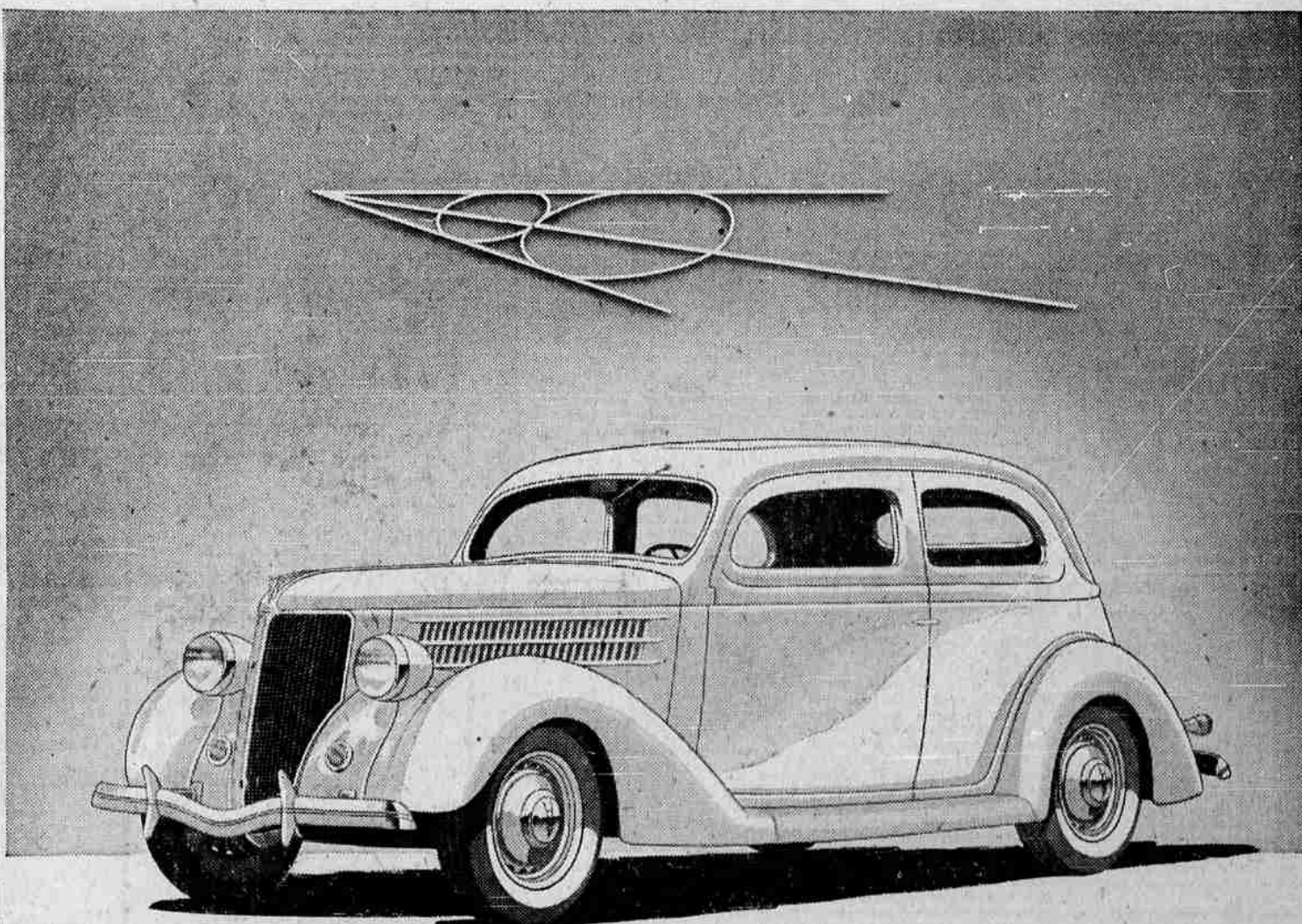
Business houses will close during the contest and the largest home crowd in some time is expected to attend. Dad's day events are scheduled to draw extra hundreds from throughout Oregon.

Their vision was impaired and they were scarcely able to talk. Attending physicians said it often took a number of days for such poisoning to run its full course.
