Auto Plants Invest Millions in 1936 Market



The automobile industry is investing millions of dollars this fall in new plants, machinery and tools for the 1936 models, many of which will be introduced before the New York Automobile Show opens November 2. NO ACCOUNTING LONG PERIODS OF CALIFORNIA FUNDS

SACRAMENTO, Oct. 26.—(UP)—Audits of state agencies responsible for the expenditures of more than \$252,000,000 have been neglected over periods ranging from two to seven years, it was revealed today by a special committee headed by Assemblyman L. M. Donihue of Oakland. As the inquiry into state finances continued, Donihue said that the state division of highways was handled \$100,000,000 since 1932 but has not been audited since that time. He also said that since the start of the San Francisco-Oakland bay bridge \$34,000,000 had been spent but no audit made of any books. Other state agencies such as the state treasury, which "has not been audited properly in 20 years, and the secretary of state's office which has not been audited in seven years were pointed to by Donihue as outstanding examples of the need of a new system which will permit the checking of financial transactions within a reasonable length of time. Donihue said "It is criminal to demand millions each month from taxpayers and then give no accounting of how money is spent. Cold figures will show how negligent the state has been and that the only cure is a new system such as I have urged from the start."

EQUITIES GO TO HIGHS FOR YEAR

NEW YORK, Oct. 26.—(AP)—Today's stock market was featured by widespread small gains, in many cases sufficient to push leading equities to new highs for a year or longer. Trading was on a more active scale for the short session than had been seen in some six weeks. Motors and a number of specialties were the ranking favorites, but all minor divisions managed to move higher on balance. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was at a new high not only for the current year but since September 14, 1931. The day's advance was 4 of a point at 52.9. A few individual issues were ahead a point or so, but few exceeded that amount in their progress.

Broker Expelled WASHINGTON, Oct. 26.—(AP)—The securities commission today ordered Michael J. Meahan, prominent Wall Street speculator, to appear and show cause why he should not be expelled from the New York and other stock exchanges in connection with alleged manipulation of the stock of Bellanca Aircraft corporation.
