

SURGEONS DETOUR MUSCLES, NERVES TO HELP CRIPPLES

New Technique Cures 'Shuffling' Foot—Flat Foot a Misleading Term, Surgeons College Informed

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 1.—(AP)—
Detouring of muscles and nerves in surgical remodeling of arms and legs to convert crippled children into strong boys and girls was described to the American College of Surgeons here today.

The operations were reported by Leroy C. Abbott M. D., and Frederick C. Bost, M. D., of the University of California medical school.
One was a 13-year-old girl with a leg deformity due to a brain injury at birth. The leg suffered from permanent spasm, stiffening and deformity because part of the brain controlling certain leg muscles did not work properly.

Strain Relieved
The surgeons cut some of the nerves leading to the faulty muscles, thereby disconnecting them partly from the haywire control. They lengthened the muscles, which had been too short, by a tendon operation. The result was to relieve the strain which had held the child's leg in deformed position.

Another operation cures the deformity variously known as "suffling foot," drag foot and hammer foot. This comes from faulty work of the peroneal muscles, which drag the foot up and down. These are long muscles running down the side of the leg.

The operation substitutes the muscles with which you raise your big toe for the foot wadding muscles. The toe muscle is the "exterior" of the foot, a long muscle extending down the leg near the shin bone and fastened to the big toe.

The operation disconnects this muscle from the big toe and fastens it over on the little toe inside of the foot, though not directly to the little toe. In that position it can raise and lower the foot.

A boy of 14, with feet so "flat" that he was unable to play or even walk without pain, had his foot bones removed and reshaped surgically, and the muscles in the feet switched and detoured into routes to operate his new feet.

"Flat Feet" Misleading
Flat feet is a misleading term, said a report by Arthur L. Fisher, M. D., of San Francisco. Feet which are automatically flat may cause no trouble, while others with a high arch may be extremely painful. It is the faulty pull of muscles or tendons rather than the shape which counts.

Dr. Fisher told of operations on the Achilles tendon in the heel which will relieve the trouble regardless of the flat or high arch of the feet.

A sinus known as sphenoid, situated near the center of the skull, back of the nose, was blamed by Chester H. Bower, M. D., of Los Angeles, for a variety of pains seldom traced to their proper source.

These troubles, he said, include headache, pain over the canine tooth, pain or continuous burning in the throat, pain in the back of the head or even in the ear. Sometimes this sinus leads to troubles in vision, he said.

WPA AIRPORT PROGRAM TO SPEND \$17,000,000 GIVEN FIRST APPROVAL

WASHINGTON, Nov. 1.—(AP)—
The commerce department has approved a \$17,000,000 airport program of the works program administration, involving the building or improvement of 250 airports. Five hundred similar projects are under consideration.

At the WPA it was explained that the commerce department approval was merely preliminary, covering engineering phases and feasibility and desirability of the projects. In each instance, it was said, the government money would go only for improvement and not for land purchases.

The projects are located in 31 states. Among the large expenditures proposed are \$1,515,902 at San Francisco; \$533,019 at San Diego, Cal.

The projects and federal funds allotted include:
Oregon: Vernonia \$4617; Eugene \$6734.
Idaho: Idaho Falls \$19,516; Valley county \$3830; Caldwell \$6003; Valley county \$7317; Payette county \$9015; Boise county \$10,202; Boise, \$24,750.

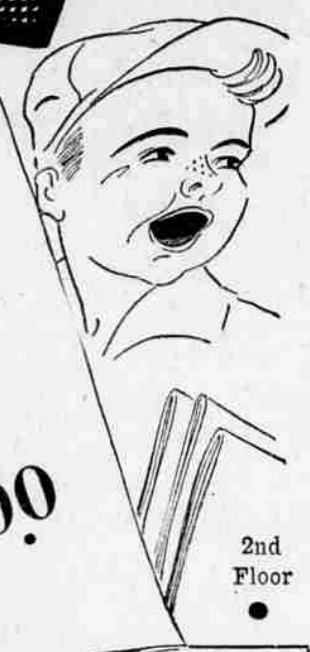
