ROAD COMMISSION LETS \$119,296 JOB ON TURKEY HILL

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 8.—(AP)—The state highway commission transacted routine business here today after awarding 11 construction contracts totaling \$903,527.25 last night.

Four more totaling \$272,303.50 were let conditionally.

Edmund Hayes, heading a delegation from the Columbia Valley Lumbermen's association, urged more use of wood in bridge building.

R. H. Baldock, state highway engineer, said he had considered and would continue to consider the merits of wood and use it when advantageous.

Commission Chairman Henry F. Cabell denied a request that contracts on overhead grade crossings be held up until a recheck was made on possible further use of wood.

FARM LOAN UNITS MAY ELECT JOINT SECY-TREASURER

Federal Land Banks are limited to a one percent margin for loans made through the local farm loan associations, the new rate now prevailing on these land bank mortgages is 4 percent, the lowest rate available in the 18 years of operation by the Land Bank system.
