

# TRAINING LASTS THROUGH CAREER OF U. S. SAILORS

The following information on naval training was issued today by the navy recruiting office here: "The training of a man in the navy continues throughout his naval career, the period at the training station being merely the first step in bridging the gap from civilian to military life, introducing the recruit to discipline and naval duties.

"The task of taking young recruits and of inculcating them with an intelligent conception of discipline and of transforming them from immature boys to self-reliant, disciplined men-o-warriors, is one requiring a high degree of leadership, tact and knowledge of human nature. "All standard psychological tests used in connection with vocational education work in colleges have been studied and experimented with in order to obtain best scientific methods of selection. "Near the end of the recruit training period it becomes necessary to select men to fill the quotas for various schools, taking into consideration the man's personal interest, natural ability to perform the details of the rating for which he wishes to be trained and the probability of his developing into a good petty officer. "The selection is based on results

from the tests and the company commander's opinion of the recruit during the training period. The tests indicate potential ability along certain lines and make it possible to select a group of men of whom a large percentage will successfully complete the intensive course of instruction and develop into valuable petty officers. "The selection of men for the navy and for courses in service schools prior to their transfer to sea is a subject that has been given careful and exhaustive study by the navy department. "The naval service offers young men an excellent opportunity for an instructive, interesting and well-paying career, world wide travel, an assured and ample retirement income after 20 and 30 years of honorable service. # NEW HAT STYLES FIND INSPIRATION IN 'HOT RHYTHMS'

By Adelaide Kerr (Associated Press Fashion Editor) PARIS (AP)—Hats inspired by American jazz are the latest fashion in advance spring and new winter headgear from Paris. Erik, the young Danish designer, who says he gets inspirations for hats from phonograph records, has launch-

ed a series of new models suggestive of all types of music from jazz to opera and Viennese waltzes. Jazz inspires new spring designs of black or navy burl straw with brims which sweep out in a wide visor at side front or roll up gently all around, and crowns encircled by twisted quills swooped about in what the designer calls "hot rhythm." Felt toques for winter are swooped up to a quill thrust aslant through the top. Black accented by a vivid "Kelly" green is the favorite combination, though purple and dull yellow accents are also used. A Viennese waltz inspires a dark velvet hat with a brim curling up on the sides and a ridge crown topped by a small ostrich plume curling forward. From military marches come toques accented by upstanding feather brushes, while the opera "Robin Hood" and Tyrolean tunes have given ideas for sports hats with peaked crown pierced by long pheasant feathers. Sports hats generally are designed of drapable felts in tones of dark green, brown and navy with soft crowns and up-rolling brims which can be pulled and draped almost any way the wearer chooses. That same idea of changing your hat to suit your face is carried out in afternoon models, some of which can be worn "backward or forward." Skull cap toques of black felt are finished with shirred felt wheels and may be worn so that the wheel slants over the eyes or lies against the back of the head, rising above the crown like a halo. One velvet model has a square eyeshade brim which can be worn rolled up like a papyrus or rolled down as the wearer wishes. Crowns in many of the mod-er taper

to points or ridges or have a tendency to jut forward. Sheer crisp velvets adorn many of the reversible models so that they may be worn falling over the eyes or cascading down the back of the neck. Stiff velvets of the wide mesh are arranged on other hats so they stand forward around the face like the brim of an old-fashioned sunbonnet and are tied under the chin with a little velvet bow.
