

BIG SURPLUS IN G.O.P. WAR CHEST SHOWN IN REPORT

National Committee Has \$260,480 to Start Campaign—Demos in Red—DuPonts Aid Leaguers

WASHINGTON, Jan. 3.—(AP)—Bringing into the 1936 campaign, the republican national committee re-

ported today that it had a surplus of \$260,480.76. Their statements to the clerk of the house were filed shortly after the American liberty league — frequent new deal critic—had revealed it spent \$389,973.92 during 1935. The republican committee reported contributions of \$336,418.41 from September 1 to December 31. It said its surplus last August 31 was \$24,985.54. Total republican expenditures in 1935 were placed at \$199,186.06, compared to \$502,924.35 by the democrats. Demos in Red The democratic committee reported unpaid obligations amounting to \$401,318.20 and unpaid pledges aggregating \$1,962, for a total of \$403,277.20. These unpaid pledges and obligations were not figured in the \$22,710.76 in cash on hand to start the campaign for reelection of President Roosevelt. The liberty league report filed by R. J. Dillon, listed receipts amounting to \$483,278.46. Largest contributors were the Du Pont family of Wilmington, Del., who provided \$138,250 in loans and contributions. The league has been a leading new deal critic. League Got Loans The Bankers Trust Company of New York made a \$20,000 loan to the league last April 29. Jovett Shouse, president of the league, was reported to have received \$51,000 during the year in salary, travel and incidental expenses. William C. Murphy, Jr., director of publicity received \$1,166.86 a month and his assistant, William Kerry, \$458.33 a month. Other disbursements for the most part, went for printing, supplies, office expenses, travel, organization and clerk hire.
