Cannot Defeat End
"I am interested in the preservation of that thing we have rather proudly called 'Jersey justice.' A stay of a comparatively few days cannot defeat that end."
Mrs. Anna Hauptmann visited her husband in the death house today, and when she came out she was smiling happily.
"We shall all soon be together again," she said, "and we'll be very happy."
Col. Mark O. Kimberling, warden, said he was convinced Hauptmann would not change the story he insists is the truth.
The warden visited Hauptmann last Saturday with C. Lloyd Fisher, one of the defense attorneys.
Colonel Kimberling, explaining why Mrs. Hauptmann apparently was permitted to visit her husband so often, pointed out that most condemned men have a dozen or more relatives who call on them, while Hauptmann has only his wife.
The editorial which drew the fire of Governor Hoffman today began: "Impeach Hoffman."
Governor Harold G. Hoffman has sacrificed all moral and legal right to serve as chief executive of New Jersey. He should be impeached and thrown out of office."

PRICE OF SILVER TAKES NEW DIVE

NEW YORK, Jan. 17.—(AP)—The price of imported bar silver in New York fell 3 cents today to 45 1/2 cents a fine ounce, the lowest price since July 30, 1934.
The New York quotation, posted by Handy & Harman, silver brokers, followed a reduction of 1/4 of a penny to 19 pence a standard ounce in the London price, equivalent in New York to 42.43 cents.
It was reported in metal circles that the reduction was forced by a lowering of the bid in New York by the United States treasury.
