or just plain 'Please' in English) and you can learn immediately whether it will rain tomorrow, what is the rate of exchange between Polish and Portuguese money, or you can order a dozen long-stemmed red roses to be sent to your mother-in-law.

At present S. V. P. service is limited to telephone subscribers, but it is planned to extend the service and establish special phone booths in postoffices, railroad stations and other public places as well as in the principal hotels where foreigners live in Paris. There are several English-speaking people in the personnel and it is hoped that eventually the information service will accommodate foreigners and Parisians alike.

The S.V.P. service will undertake almost any job, from offering information as to where a dog license may be obtained to undertaking to

run personal errands. The tariff depends upon the nature of the problem and is charged on the monthly telephone bill.

If someone merely wants to know when the hunting season starts, he will be charged the minimum rate of one franc (7 cents). For the same sum information like the following may be obtained:

How many stamps needed on a letter to Czechoslovakia; where to buy a dozen oysters at 1 a.m.; or what station to go to for a Bordeaux train.

Beyond the garden variety of information, the price naturally mounts according to the complications involved. For example, information on the price of a gas mask in Soviet Russia, or how many countries have applied sanctions, will cost from three to five francs. The price would be even steeper for a certain loga-

rithm or just how many people died of leprosy in 1931.

For information on a special book from the library, getting a boiled shirt from the laundry, or ordering flowers to be delivered by a special cyclist, the monthly telephone bill will mount considerably.

ROCK ISLAND, Ill., Jan. 17.—(AP)—Dr. G. A. Brande, 78, president emeritus of the Evangelical Lutheran Augustans Synod, and nationally known churchman, died in a hospital today of pneumonia. Dr. Brande served as president of the synod from 1918 to June, 1935, when he was retired.

EK WALL AGAINST TOWNSEND PLAN

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 17.—(AP)—Congressman William A. Ekwall, here today on a brief visit from the national capitol, said bluntly he will not vote for the Townsend old age pension plan if it reaches the house of representatives this session.

Neither will he vote for the McGroarty bill which embraces the Townsend plan features, he said.

"I will vote for any bill or amendment to the social security act which will provide greater pay-

ments to the aged in keeping with the ability of the nation to pay the costs," he said.

CRISTOBAL, C. Z., Jan. 17.—(UP)—Reliable but unconfirmed reports today said Greta Garbo was traveling incognito aboard the Swedish freighter, Margaret Johnson, which passed through the Panama canal en route from Gothenburg, Sweden, to San Francisco.

According to the reports the actress was on the passenger list as Finn Berg, a 38-year-old American. The steamer's agents here denied the film star was aboard the vessel.
