HIGH TEST HERDS OF ROGUE VALLEY LISTED IN REPORT

E. B. Poyer's herd of 24 grade and pure-bred Jersey cows tested high for the 20 herds tested with an average of 698 pounds of milk with 41.4 average test for butterfat, the monthly test report of the Rogue River Herd Improvement association shows for December.

Frank Schutzwahl's herd of 13 cows tested high for herds of that size, with a milk production average of 758 pounds, 42.5 average for butterfat. His herd is made up of grade and pure-bred Jerseys. High herd under 12 cows belongs to George Stowell, nine pure-bred Guerneys, testing 796 pounds of milk with an average of 46.6 for butterfat.

The two high cows tested were Stowell's "Queen Esther," six-year old pure-bred Guernsey producing 1275 pounds of milk with a butterfat content of 47.99, and E. B. Poyer's "Matilda," a grade Jersey, producing 1425 pounds of milk, with 88.9 pounds of fat.

S. B. Hill, route 1, Central Point, with 15 grade Holsteins and Jerseys, was listed as a new member of the association. Seegmiller & Williams purchased a pure-bred Jersey herd sire during the month, the report shows.

Two "bonders," detected in the herds by the tests conducted, were sold.
