ROSEBURG TO TRY AGAIN FOR GRANT

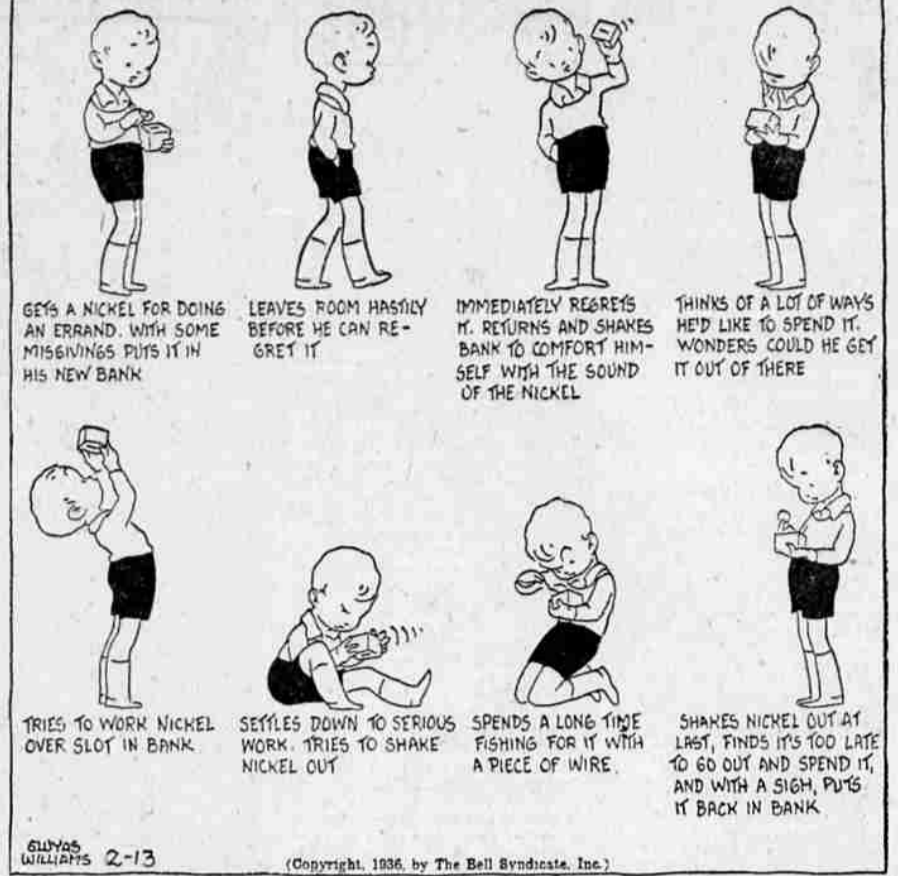
ROSEBURG, Ore., Feb. 13.—(AP)—A resolution asking the federal government to give the city of Roseburg a 45 per cent grant in the PWA project for construction

of a trunk line sewer and sewage disposal plant was voted by the city council here last night. The original project, which provided an 18 per cent grant, was abandoned recently by the council, when an advertisement for bids resulted in only one offer, which was in the sum of \$95,000 or approximately \$20,000 above estimates.

At present PWA projects are receiving a 45 per cent grant, the city hopes to be able to secure that proportion of federal cooperation, which would keep the city's cost within the \$57,000 originally authorized.
