## SAFETY CAMPAIGN WILL BE EXTENDED TO HIGH SCHOOLS

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 15.—Intensive safety education programs now reaching millions of grade school children will be extended to high schools throughout the nation in a new campaign against traffic fatalities sponsored by the American Automobile association.

The program for safety education in high schools is embodied in a course of "Sportsmanlike Driving" prepared by the A.A.A.'s safety and traffic engineering department with cooperation by leading educators and is designed to teach prospective motorists the techniques of safe and sane automobile operation.

"In making available a course in safe driving to high school students," said Thomas P. Henry of Detroit, Michigan, president of the A.A.A., "we are attacking the very core and center of the traffic accident problem, both of the present and of the future. In addition to teaching mechanical features of the car, 'Sportsmanlike Driving' discusses traffic regulations and impresses the need for safety both from the individual viewpoint and from the standpoint of broad social responsibility. Among the subjects included are: 'How the Automobile Ruins,' 'How to Drive an Automobile,' 'Keeping the Automobile in Safe Condition,' 'Physical, Mental and Emotional Characteristics of the Driver,' 'Accident Factors,' 'Driver Responsibility and Examination and Test for Operator's License.'

"With complete instruction in all the subjects included in the course it is inevitable that the student will become a far more competent and efficient driver than he possibly could through the haphazard and sketchy type of instruction so prevalent today.

"Widespread use of this course will, I am convinced, not only improve almost immediately the worst

phase of our present day traffic record, but through constantly turning out better and more efficient motorists, make the highway of the future a safer place on which to drive."

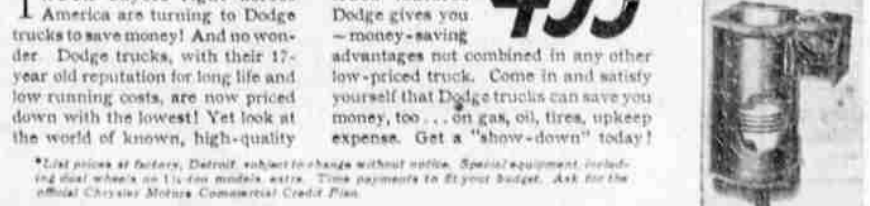

## BORAH AND KNOX SEEK GOP FAVOR IN OHIO PRIMARY

WASHINGTON, Feb. 15.—(UP)—The Borah for President organization tonight opened the campaign to win Ohio's 52 Republican national convention delegates from Frank Knox of Chicago.

Carl G. Bachmann, chairman of the national Borah for President committee, called a state-wide conference of Ohio friends of the senator to meet in Akron Sunday.

Both Borah and Knox are to contest the Ohio presidential primary which takes place May 12. Borah has filed his entry and Knox headquarters has applied for the necessary papers. It appears to political observers that the contest for delegates other than favorite son movements will be largely between the senator and the Chicago publisher. Other possible Republican nominees have been reluctant so far to go outside their own states for delegate strength.

Bachmann's announcement revealed developments in Borah's Ohio plans since he announced that he would enter the primary there. The senator believed at first he would seek support of only Ohio's eight delegates-at-large. Subsequently he made public demand that the regular Ohio Republican organization abandon plans for a favorite son of uninstructed delegation. He urged that her eligible Republicans enter the primary.

Knox and Borah are in the Illinois primary contest. Whether they will
