DUCK POPULATION SHOWS INCREASE

WASHINGTON, Feb. 18. (AP)—Biological survey officials today said preliminary returns of the national duck inventory made several weeks ago indicated an increase in the numbers of migratory water fowl this year.

About 30 days will be required to complete tabulations and to ascertain exactly how many ducks were in this country at the present time.

The 1935 duck inventory resulted in an estimate that there were 17 million ducks in this country and about 10 million in Mexico. A large part was attributed to the stringent hunting regulations placed in effect last fall.
