candidate admitted it, but said: "Those things are all beyond us. If I am going to get it, that is my destiny and there is no use running away from it or resisting it."

It is difficult to prove how much there is in the stories going around that the New Dealers are encouraging the Borah Republican candidacy. One of the stories is worth telling, however, only as a humorous improbability.

It is related in the senate cloak room that the Idaho Republican was calling on Mr. Roosevelt at the White House some weeks ago. The president interrupted the conversation to ask: "Bill, why don't you go into the Illinois primary?"

Borah is supposed to have replied that he was thinking about it. The president reached for a telephone, saying: "I'll call up Chicago and get you some delegates out there."

Some of these congressmen who have been making speeches for economy have begun to change their tune privately. Letters have been coming in from back home protesting against WPA cuts. Also protests have been piling up against curtailing CCC camps. This situation has already been grappled down Pennsylvania avenue to the White House.

The smart idea of having states come into the supreme court with appeals to uphold the Guffey coal act is supposed to have been arranged by Senator Guffey himself. He passed the word around, far in advance, that the state briefs would be filed.

The idea is more political than legal. Most of the briefs are not legalistic arguments, but merely assertions that the states cannot regulate the industry and that therefore the federal government should do it. A few of the briefs admit that the states could make compacts, but say this is impractical.

Townsend investigators of the house are already having their inner troubles. One group within the investigating committee wants to emulate Senator Black. It urged the sending of detectives to all sections of the country to learn how the Townsendites are working from the inside. Another group wants to start hearings and develop the evidence from Townsend witnesses.

A compromise is in the making whereby the committee will do a little of both.

## FIRST FHA LOAN HERE APPROVED

What was described as the first local loan under title 2 of the federal housing act was announced today by the Medford Federal Savings & Loan association.

The loan, to mature in 15 years, was made to J. P. Naumes on the stone home he is erecting on South Oakdale avenue about a block south of the high school.

Notice that the financing had been approved was received today from Jamieson Parker, FHA administrator for Oregon.

"The federal housing act provides the easiest payment plan and the lowest interest rates ever attain-

able here for legitimate home building," said J. H. Fletcher, secretary-manager of the loan association. He added that many inquiries are being received regarding home building.

## TITLE 1 OF FHA TO EXPIRE SOON

Unless congress provides for an extension, title 1 of the federal housing act will expire March 31, the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce pointed out today in counseling residents to take advantage of the attractive financing facilities provided by the law before its expiration.

It is under title 1 that low terms may be procured for modern household equipment and the remodeling and rebuilding of homes.

The chamber was prepared today to send a telegram to Sen. Charles McNary requesting that he use his influence in having title 1 extended. This far congress has shown no inclination to continue that section of the act.
