Style News from Paris and London

LONDON—(AP)—An afternoon dress which gives a slimming line to the hips and width to the shoulders is covered with narrow crepe braid which is stitched closely together in diagonal lines. Sleeves also are covered with the braid. . . . Fine china buttons are being used on some of the new spring dresses, while a piece of rope stuck together with sealing wax might be used as a belt.

PARIS—(AP)—Book buttons lend a "highbrow" air to several new mid-season frocks. They are tiny, closed volumes of black enamel whose leaves are edged with gold. . . . A "belt and buckle" print is something new in spring fabrics. A dark blue crepe is printed with the design of a red buckle and a short length of belt instead of the overworked flower patterns which have been so long in vogue.

Cork is the next thing to be woven into wools. After feathers, hair, lin-glass and gold and silver threads have all been used. Rodier weaves a spring wool with thin lozenges of cork about the size of a penny woven into the wool. The material is a shadow plaid.

Plats play a prominent role in spring fashions. Sleeves, bodices and skirts of day frocks are worked in fine pleats and evening gowns have insets of sun-ray pleating. Short fan-pleated capes top several evening frocks.
