WING SELLS LOT FOR NEW LAUNDRY ON CENTRAL AVE.

Plans for the construction and operation of a new laundry here were disclosed yesterday by the announcement of the sale of a lot on North Central avenue, adjoining the Elks temple on the north, to Grady Johnson of Marshfield.

Mr. Johnson, it was learned, intends to enter the laundry business here. He operated a laundry in Marshfield for six years, having sold out his business there recently. After surveying prospects in Oregon, northern California and southern Washington, he concluded that Medford had the brightest future, it was said.

When Mr. Johnson was here the early part of last week he concluded arrangements for purchase of the lot from Mrs. Della O'Toole of Ashland. The transaction was handled by the Charles A. Wing Agency, Inc.

Mr. Johnson, the agency stated, plans to build a one-story, reinforced concrete structure 50 feet wide and 100 feet deep. It is to be modern in every respect and fitted with the latest in laundry equipment. The site was considered ideal because while it was close to the downtown business section it would also allow an abundance of natural light for the laundry.

Plans and specifications, it was understood, are now being prepared here so that bids for the construction of the building may be requested in 30 days.

Mr. Johnson was expected to return here tomorrow with his wife and 16-year old daughter to take up permanent residence in Medford. It was understood he would have Medford associates in business with him here. The business will be known as "The Troy Laundry."

Mr. Johnson has been active in civic affairs in Marshfield where he is a member of the Rotary club.
