

# Four Nations Watchful As Facists and Socialists Fight to Control Spain

Germany and Italy See Disaster if Liberals  
Should Retain Power Over Republic;  
France and Russia Oppose

(Editors Note: Today, the eyes of the world are centered on revolution-torn Spain. The dramatic developments of the last two days have increased the danger of the conflict spreading beyond the country. Will there be another international war? The chief of the foreign service of the Associated Press gives, in the following article, a picture of the situation as it stands today.)

NEW YORK, Aug. 21.—Italy's threat to aid the Spanish fascist rebels fully reveals the danger of another world war.

The threat to send the Italian air armada to fight against the Spanish government unless France ceases "openly" aiding the Spanish socialist government came in an unofficial way, but fits in perfectly with the whole picture.

Spain is the battlefield of fascism and liberalism, the latter represented by socialists and communists.

Germany, Italy, fascist countries, would think it dangerous and disastrous if the Spanish government should remain in power, because they are convinced communists eventually would take charge.

They fear communism would be strengthened in France, civil war occur there and western Europe become a ferment of socialism, communism and anarchism which the fascist countries would deem dangerous to their dictatorial governments.

France, newly gone socialist, with communism a strong minority, morally supports Spain's socialist government.

Italy, asserts France, aids the Spanish socialists "openly."

Whatever the exact truth, France and communist Russia anxiously and openly hope Spain's socialist liberal government will win and crush out fascism, still a threat in France.

Four-fifths of the army is fighting with the fascist rebels.

The socialist government has only the remaining one-fifth of regular troops and an improvised, ill-trained militia.

It is the organized army against the embattled citizenry.

Republic since 1931

Spain became a republic in 1931 because the people revolted against what they thought intolerable control by the king's courtiers, priests and land owners.

For five years Spain has struggled to find herself, each new government disappointing the country.

Finally, elections last February showed an almost even division between all brands of liberals and all brands of fascists, land-owners, soldiers and moderates.

The apparent evenness of the present fighting indicates there is no overwhelming desire of the whole people for either fascism or mixed communism and socialism. At present the rebels appear to have a slight edge over the government.

## NAB PAIR IN ACT USING JIMMY ON PIN BALL GAME

ASHLAND, Aug. 21.—(Spl.)—City police early Thursday afternoon arrested two men in the act of allegedly defrauding a pinball machine at the Lithia hotel, and subsequent investigation led Chief Talent to suspect that they are wanted in a number of other places.

The two men, accompanied by Mrs. Luntich and her four-year-old child, arrived in Ashland Wednesday night and stayed at the Columbia hotel.

The men, now in the local jail, had played the machines in the Palace cafe but Talent said they had been closely watched and had been unable to have things their own way.

The pair had about 70 in their possession, including \$8 or \$9 in nickels.

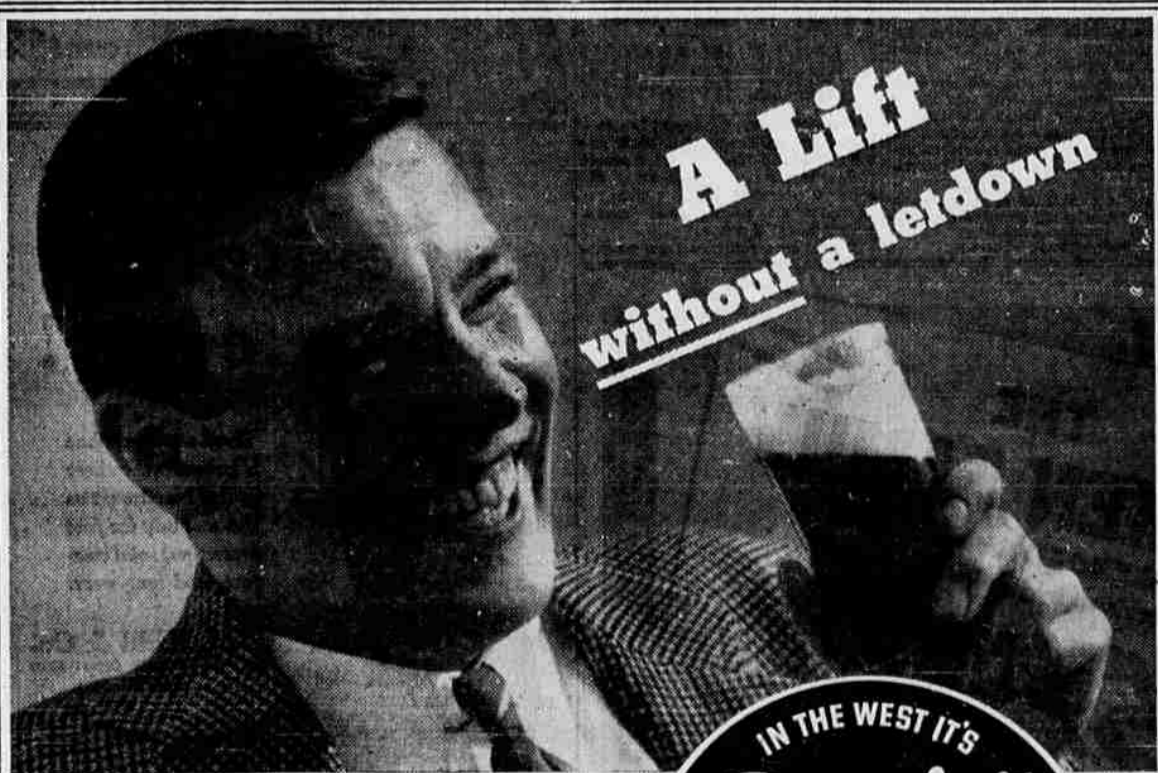
