

LAKES OF CASCADE AREA ARE STOCKED WITH 778,000 FISH

The Rogue river National forest in cooperation with the state game commission today had completed planting 778,000 fish in the lakes of the Cascade divide in Jackson and Klamath counties. Except for a few of the larger lakes which are accessible by road, the fish were packed in by use of horses and mules. The distribution and species of the fish as planted were as follows:

- Lake Harriette, 14,000 eastern brook.
- Clover Lake, 9,000 eastern brook.
- Dee Lake, 6,000 eastern brook.
- Bert Lake, 4,000 eastern brook.
- Beals (Lone) Lake, 10,000 eastern brook.
- Lake Cary, 10,000 eastern brook.
- Blue Rock Group No. 4,000 eastern brook.
- Blue Rock Group No. 5,000 eastern brook.
- Pear Lake, 20,000 eastern brook.
- Heavenly Twins, 20,000 rainbow.
- Inherwood Lakes, 10,000 rainbow.
- Puck Lakes, 10,000 eastern brook.
- Marguerite Lake, 7,000 eastern brook.
- Donna Lake, 3,000 eastern brook.
- Horseshoe (Sky Lake), 10,000 eastern brook.
- Island Lake, 20,000 rainbow.
- Four Mile Lake, 100,000 (15,000 E. brook, 85,000 rainbow.)
- Fish Lake, 525,000 eastern brook.

A forest service bulletin describes the work as follows: "ERA crews were used to assist in this planting project and all 17 lakes along the Sky Lakes area and in the Mountain lakes primitive area were stocked. As many of these lakes were accessible only by trail, pack strings of horses and mules were used in transporting the fish from the end of the road to the lakes. The total mileage involved on these pack trips was approximately 300 miles. The largest single pack was to Clover lake in the primitive area, which was an 18 mile round trip.

"The fingerlings were shipped from the state hatchery at Crooked Creek to the Cold Springs packers camp on the Pelican Butte road in large cans containing approximately 1000 rainbow trout or 500 eastern brook trout, the fish averaging in size from 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 inches in length, the eastern brook being the larger. At the end of the roads the cans were loaded on the pack animals.

"The water temperature in the cans at the beginning of the trip was approximately 35 degrees. As the water warmed considerably during the pack trip, and sudden changes of temperature result in high mortality of the fingerlings, and since most of the lakes planted have an average temperature of 68 to 70 degrees, it was necessary to submerge the closed cans in the lake water for about five minutes to allow a gradual equalization of the temperature. Very few fish were lost. Two hundred out of 10,000 packed into Harriette lake on the first trip to the Mountain lakes primitive area, were lost but in later trips only about 25 out of 9,000 which were packed into Clover lake, failed to survive.

"Four Mile, Blue Rock, and Clover lake were planted with fresh water shrimp for fish food. An investigation of the fish which were planted last season was made at the same time the planting was carried on this year. It was found that the rainbow trout which were stocked last season averaged about 5 1/2 inches and eastern brook about 8 1/2 inches in length. In different lakes, however, the sizes of the fish vary. It is apparent that the temperature of the water is reflected in the rate of growth of planted fingerlings. In the cooler lakes they are smaller in size by approximately an inch during the first year than they are in the warmer lakes.

"Considerable game was seen during the transporting of the fish. These consisted mainly of bear and deer. Yellow jackets encountered by the pack strings provided the most trouble and in several instances almost resulted in loss of the fish.

"The origin of the names of some of the lakes is rather interesting, among them being Dee lake which was named after Dee Wright, deceased northwest packer and woodsman; Bert lake, named after Bert Withrow, deceased, an old pioneer in Klamath county who hunted in the territory of this lake; Beals lake, named after Bill Beals, pioneer of Klamath and Jackson counties, who trapped in the Beal lake territory as early as 1874. City lake was named after Cary Hamaby, deceased Klamath county pioneer. Pear lake was named because of the shape of the lake resembling that of a pear. Island lake derives its name from the fact that it contains several islands.

"The origin of the name Heavenly Twins for those two lakes is not known but the appearance of the lakes certainly justify this term. Inherwood lakes, first planted in 1935, were named after F. W. Inherwood, one of J. B. Waldo's party which included Mr. Minto, William Taylor, E. J. Humanson, who in 1888 made the trip down the skyline trail from Mt. Hood to Mt. Shasta. Initials of this party were carved on a tree at the southeast end of the lake with the date September 13, 1888."

The forest service also assisted the United States Bureau of Fisheries at Butte Falls in planting 70,000 steelhead in the upper Rogue river and its tributaries. In addition it is planned to stock the upper south fork of Lit-

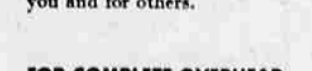
