Certificate of water right No. 2895 was issued to Fred R. Benedict, confirming an appropriation under permit No. 4200 for the use of 0.38 cubic foot per second of the waters of Applegate River, for the irrigation of 15 acres in the NW 1/4, Section 22, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of August 6, 1919, through the New Berryman Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located approximately 1450 feet South and 40 feet West from the North Quarter corner of Section 26, same township and range.

The applicant herein proposes to convey the water through the Foxler-Keller or Kuhl Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located approximately 2000 feet South and 750 feet East from the North Quarter corner of Section 29, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M., with a date of priority of August 6, 1919, through the New Berryman Ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located approximately 1450 feet South and 40 feet West from the North Quarter corner of Section 26, same township and range.
