

"A Midsummer Night's Dream" Opens On Craterian's Program Today

GALAXY OF SCREEN HEADLINERS APPEAR IN BRILLIANT FILM

The much heralded Max Reinhardt production of "A Midsummer Night's Dream," classed by most as Shakespeare's greatest comedy, and which has been acclaimed throughout the world as a film masterpiece, opens its popular price run at the Craterian theatre today. It will play three days.
