Heaven in a School Lunch Box! Sandwiches, Cake and An Apple. By ELSIE STARK

Breathes there a child who doesn't prefer a sandwich to a cooked meal? Probably not. Children love to eat snacks, and that's why school lunch boxes are such fun. Nice white or whole wheat bread with delicious filling... a big, shiny apple... a piece of cake or a couple of sugar cookies... that's a heavenly meal in a child's opinion. We can keep our fruit cups, hot soups and roasts.

Since sandwiches mean so much to a youngster, by all means make them tasty and attractive. Often mothers aren't around when children eat their school lunches. The food must sell itself, so to speak, without benefit of sermon.

A good idea is to give a child one sandwich containing meat or eggs and another made of something sweet. Here is a practical suggestion: Chopped Tongue and Egg Sandwiches.

2 slices tongue, chopped 2 slices tomato, chopped 1 hard-cooked egg, chopped 3 tablespoons Best Foods Real Mayonnaise
